# **Digital Solutions Services**




As more records are being created electronically, new challenges in access and preservation must be met. In response, MCX-CMAC offers a variety of services for electronic records and digital images, including scanning and digitization of records, development of file directory structures and naming conventions for file names, migration and conversion of electronic files, and the creation of customized retrieval systems to provide unprecedented access to these resources.

MCX-CMAC can digitize physical records (i.e., hard copies) in accordance with rigorous standards to ensure survival of original records as well as provide greater access to these materials through the creation of electronic record indices that enable more accurate and faster access to large volumes of existing electronic data.

#### **Digital Solutions services offered by MCX-CMAC**

- Scanning and digitizing records
- Reformatting printed records to microfilm for long-term curation
- Data migration and conversion
- Development of collaborative tools for distribution (i.e., electronic indices)
