Description: PERMIT FILES OPEN TO PUBLIC REVIEW EXCEPT FOR CERTAIN DOCUMENTS.

- 1. The purpose of this Regulatory Guidance Letter is to clarify our procedures for handling correspondence received on permit applications, in particular, Congressional correspondence.
- 2. Permit case files are public records and as such any information in the file is releasable under the Freedom of Information Act. Certain documents, such as those protected by attorney-client privilege, do not have to be released and, preferably, should not be placed in the official permit case file.
- 3. All external correspondence received on a permit application is releasable. However, as a matter of courtesy, correspondence from public officials requiring a response is to be answered whenever possible prior to releasing the correspondence. If a letter from a member of Congress or other public official must be released prior to responding, the member of Congress or public official will be informed in advance.
