

SOMETHING EVERY YOUNG MAN NEEDS TO KNOW ABOUT SELECTIVE SERVICE

Men 18 through 25 living in America, including documented or undocumented immigrants, must register with Selective Service.

Registration is one of the civic responsibilities every young man inherits as an adult. By registering, he stays eligible for college loans and grants, job training, and federal jobs, and citizenship for immigrants. Many states and municipalities have similar reciprocal eligibility requirements for benefits.
