# We all have to do our part to keep America strong.

Men, citizens and non-citizens, living in America must register with the Selective Service System within 30 days of their 18th birthday. It's the law!

It is one of the civic responsibilities every young man inherits as an adult. By registering, he stays eligible for college loans and grants, job training, and Federal jobs, and citizenship for immigrants. Many states and municipalities have similar reciprocal eligibility requirements for benefits.

As an influencer, please do your part. Help young men be aware that it is important to register with Selective Service. Help remind them to be smart, register on-time.

The enclosed CDs and DVD (Windows and Mac compatible) include an array of tools to help communicate the registration message. They include:

**DVD Disc:** Narrated, scripted, and self-paced full-motion presentations; TV public service announcements, historical film clips from WWI, WWII, and Korea.

With your help, no young man should be in violation of the law, nor denied the benefit of eligibility for jobs, loans, training, and citizenship because he did not understand the requirement to register with Selective Service.
