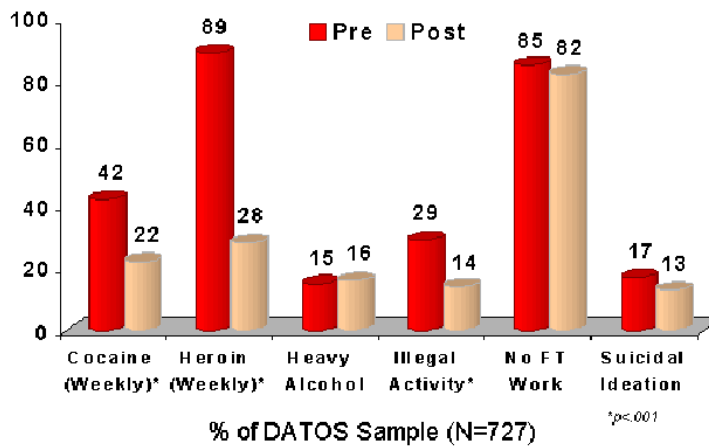

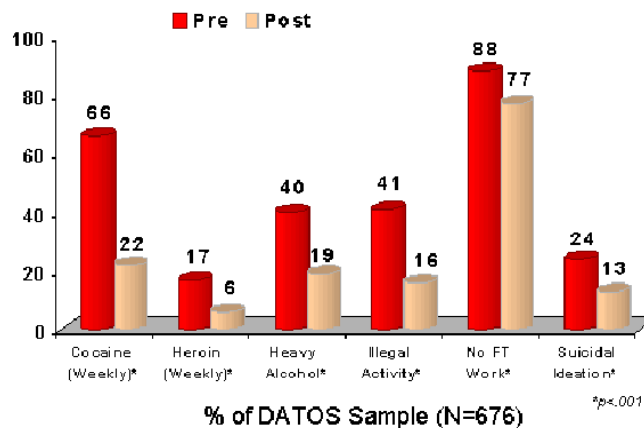
Key findings from the 1-year follow-up are shown in the following graphs:

Changes from Before to After Treatment



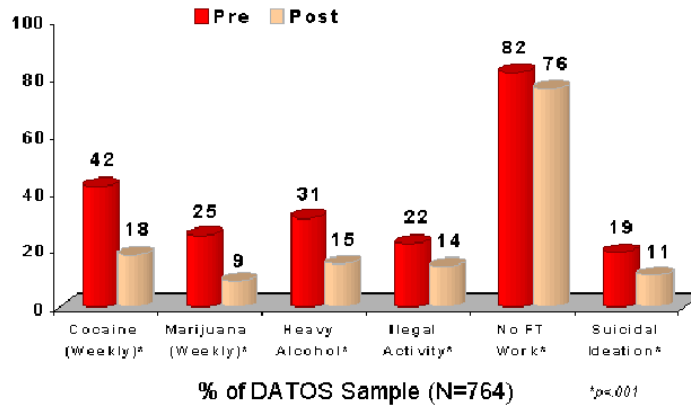

Changes from Before to After Treatment



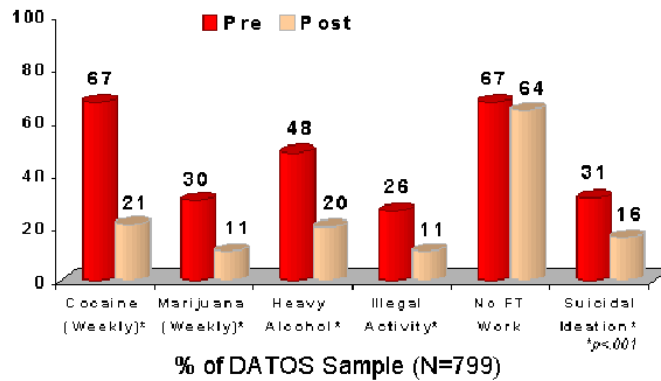
