

**AIRMAN'S ATTIC RULES
& FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

1. WHO IS ALLOWED TO USE THE AIRMAN'S ATTIC?

AB (E-1) through SrA (E-4) and their dependents. Staff Sergeant (E-5) with dependents and their family. Parents, grandparents and other non-dependent family members are not allowed to visit the Airman's Attic. Staff Sergeants (E-5) without dependents and all NCO's with dependents may shop on the last working day (this means the last functioning Airman's Attic work day) of the month and are allowed only 6 regular items and no large items.

2. WHEN IS THE AIRMAN'S ATTIC OPEN?

The Airman's Attic hours are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10am-1pm.

Please check the signs on the door for days that we may be closed due to holidays or other circumstances.

3. WHAT ITEMS AM I ALLOWED TO TAKE?

- Clothes and shoes are unlimited and DO NOT count as an item. (New, boxed, brand name shoes count as an item)
- Children's toys such as Fisher Price, Little Tikes, Step Two, etc. will count as an item
- You are allowed 12 other items a month. One (1) of your 12 items may be a large item worth \$50 or more.
- You are allowed 1 BX/boxed item per visit (Some of these items may be large items meaning it will count as your large & boxed item.)
- Some items (as determined by the volunteers) will count as sets. These are as follows:
 - VHS tapes and DVD's count as one (1) item each.
 - Compact Disks (CD's) - 1 CD = 1 item
 - Record Albums, and Cassette Tapes - 2 media = 1 item
 - Dishes, Pots, and Pans - if they form a complete set, it counts as one (1) item.
You are allowed one set every 6 months. (Set must be appropriate to family size.)
 - Computer and Accessory Devices (This includes monitors, CPU's, scanners, and printers) Allowed 1 per year.
 - Book Limits: *Children's Books= 10 bks/month *Adult Books= 5 bks/month.

Military Clothing items DO NOT count towards your items, but they are limited!

- You are allowed only 1 BDU Field Jacket or BDU camouflage Gortex Jacket during your membership.
- You are allowed only 1 pair of combat boots per year.
- You are allowed 1 pair of dress blues shoes every 6 months.
- You are allowed 1 DCU uniform or jacket every 12 months (per year).
- You are allowed 2 sets of blues per month.
- You are allowed 1 set of BDUs every 6 months
- You are allowed 1 blues sweater, 1 blues rain jacket and 1 blues coat every 6 months.

4. DORM RESIDENTS MAY NOT TAKE FURNITURE

5. YOU MAY NOT TAKE MULTIPLE REPEATED ITEMS (Volunteers will review your records as needed)

6. YOU MAY ONLY TAKE CLOTHES THAT ARE AGE APPROPRIATE FOR YOUR CURRENT FAMILY MEMBERS!

(EXAMPLE: If you have a 2 year old, you may take clothes in that age range or close. Please do not take 18 month child clothes if you have a newborn or a four year old. Also please DO NOT take clothes for non-dependents.)

7. YOU MAY NOT RETURN OR EXCHANGE ITEMS. YOU MAY HOWEVER RE-DONATE THE ITEM IF YOU NO LONGER NEED IT.

8. SELLING ITEMS YOU ACQUIRED FROM THE AIRMAN'S ATTIC IS NOT ALLOWED. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT YOUR FIRST SERGEANT WILL BE CONTACTED.

9. THE ATTIC IS RUN BY VOLUNTEERS. Everything you receive from the Airman's Attic is free and it is a privilege for you to be able to shop here. Please DO NOT ABUSE this privilege. Treat the volunteers with respect and you will be treated with respect.

10. THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE AS NEEDED BY THE MANAGER! ALL RULE CHANGES ARE RETROACTIVELY ENFORCED.
