

## APPENDIX Z

### AIR COMMODITY AND AIR SPECIAL HANDLING CODES

#### A. GENERAL

The air commodity and air special handling codes are a two-position combination. The first position of the code identifies the commodity and the second position identifies the nature of the commodity, which may require special handling. The specific special handling requirements are usually further identified in trailer data (e.g., actual temperature control range or type of hazardous materiel). The most current versions of the codes are available at the USTRANSCOM Reference Data Management (TRDM) website at: <https://trdm.c2.amc.af.mil/trdm/index.jsp> for Air Commodity codes then click on DTR Data and Air Commodity. Select Display Data from Action Legends box.
