The United States Mission wishes to remind the Permanent Missions that, pursuant to Section 257 (b) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, all Mission employees of the Permanent Missions who are pending or current United States Permanent Residents must complete form I-508, "Waiver of Rights, Privileges, Exemptions and Immunities." Failure to do so may jeopardize their continued status as a Permanent Resident.

Any member of the Permanent Mission who is a pending or current United States Permanent Resident and has not personally completed a form I-508 should do so now and return the completed forms to the United States Mission's Office of Host Country Affairs.
