Job Posting Information

- <u>Title</u> The job title ensures that job posting will display properly on the portal for the spouse and partner.
- <u>Job ID</u> Properly displays the Job ID that the company has posted. It is used to track job posting for the company internally and through the portal.
- <u>Created</u> The date the job posting was most recently updated. Important for the
 partners as it tracks when the job was created for the MSEP Portal and will ensure that
 they are not duplicate postings for the same job as they are pulled from the crawl each
 night.
- <u>Updated</u> The date that the job posting was most recently updated. Will ensure that
 there are not duplicate posting for the same job as they are pulled from the crawl each
 night.
- URL The unique URL of the job posting on your company's site. Importance of this
 field is to properly ensure the specific information for a job posting is pulled over to
 display all the requirements set by the MSEP Program Team. This creates the
 opportunity to have positions uploaded with accuracy and provide information for
 tracking purposes. These results in the job posting will in-turn upload with a quicker
 response time than a manual upload.
- <u>Industry</u> The industry that this job posting falls under. This will streamline the process so the Dash Reports will properly track by Industry and Sub Industry. You must use MSEP defined values (exactly).

- <u>Education</u> Required level of education for this job posting. Multiple terms can be used in the posting. By providing the education level it gives the spouse a clear understanding of the job they are applying for within the portal.
- <u>Credentials</u> Required credentials (certifications or licenses) for this job posting.
 Providing this information will ensure that the spouse is clear on any additional credentials, license required or preferred for the job posting.
- Addtl Qualifications This field specifies whether the job posting is salaried or paid by the hour. Providing this information will ensure that the spouse is aware of this job posting being Salary or Hourly.
- <u>Compensation Type</u> This field specifies whether the job posting is salaried or paid by the hour. Providing this information will ensure that the spouse is aware of this job posting being Salary or Hourly.
- <u>Hourly Rate</u> The hourly wage for this job posting. This field may be left blank if it is not applicable. The field may contain only integers and/or a period. It should not contain any other punctuation, such as a dollar sign or comma.
- <u>Salary</u> The starting or minimum salary for this job posting. This field may be left blank if it not applicable.
- Address The street address associated within the job posting. The actual work location of the position being posted on the portal. The candidate knows exactly where they are applying for instead of applying through the corporate office then finding out the position is outside their travel comfort zone. Provides the spouse with a more accurate location of the position they have now posted for within the portal.
- Address 2 Second line of address associated with the job posting.



- <u>City</u> The city in which the job will be performed. Clearly defines the specific city for the
 job posting instead of the corporate office location. Ensures that the spouse is aware of
 the actual location of the desired job.
- <u>State</u> The state or province associated with the job posting. Clearly defines the specific State for the job posting instead of the corporate office location. Ensures that the spouse is aware of the actual location of the desired job.
- <u>Postal</u> The postal code associated with the job posting. Clearly defines the specific Postal Code for the job posting instead of the corporate office location. Ensures that the spouse is aware of the actual location of the desired job.
- <u>Country</u> The country associated with the job posting Clearly defines the specific country for the job posting instead of the corporate office location. Ensures that the spouse is aware of the actual location of the desired job.
