By this letter, I am making a request under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), pursuant to 5 USC 552, et seq. for copies of the above-referenced aerial photographs.

These are aerial photographs which show portions of property in Franklin County with the current legal descriptions of Block 15, Unit 244 in Range 28 EWM and Government Lot 2, Section 36, Township 12 North, Range 28, East Willamette Meridian

The area in question is located east of the northern end of Johnson Island on the eastern bank of the Columbia River. The location is approximately 14 miles north of Richland.

With the assistance of Mr. Dan Ostegaard (509-376-3976) in the Lockheed Martin Building at 2490 off Smart Park and Garlick Drives, I have already located and viewed prints of the above-referenced aerial photographs. However, I would now like to order copies of them. I was instructed by Mr. Ostegaard to proceed through your office with a FOIA request.

I have attempted to find these aerial photographs on your website but have been unsuccessful. Furthermore, I understand that prints made in your archive department from negatives would be

of higher quality and more acceptable for my purposes than reproductions made from your website.


