This office is in receipt of your amended Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated August 5, 2010, for all information that pertains to NPD 6163, which to your knowledge, is a Knolls Atomic Power Laboratory purchase order that may contain related Material Balance Report documentation, along with other information that would be of interest to you.

We have conducted a thorough search of the archived Hanford Site databases using the key words NPD6163, NPD-6163 and NPD 6163 and no documents were located. This search was conducted by those within the agency who are most familiar with the subject matter of your request, in locations where documents would most likely be found.
