#### **Technology Roadmaps**

A **technology roadmap** is a plan that matches short-term and long-term goals with specific technology solutions to help meet those goals.

Developing a roadmap has three major uses.

- Helps reach a consensus about a set of needs -collaborate
- It provides a mechanism to help forecast technology developments –cofounding through coalitions
- It provides a framework to help plan and coordinate technology developments -coordination

We need to agree on technical priorities for future research!

- Each roadmap is at varying level of completeness
- Roadmaps can be designed in many formats and each organization decides what format and level of detail is most useful to them
- Most roadmaps are living documents and are updated and revised as needed
