24 Hour Report E 2421 Motor Vehicle Accident

Subject: BLM engine accident in southern Idaho

What: A BLM Heavy engine (E 2421) traveling between the Castleford area and

the Juniper Butte Guard Station on the Twin Falls District was involved in

a roll-over accident, resulting in injuries to three firefighters.

When: August 14, 2006 6:29 PM MDT

Narrative: A type 4 BLM engine (E 2421) with three employees was returning to the

Juniper Butte guard station from the Castleford area when the operator

lost control of the vehicle, resulting in a roll-over accident. One

employee's condition was stabilized at Magic Valley Regional Hospital in

Twin Falls, Idaho. He was than transported by air evacuation to St. Alphonsus Hospital in Boise with significant, but non-life threatening injuries. The other two employees, with minor injuries, were transported by ambulance to Magic Valley Regional Hospital where they were treated

and released. The accident is under investigation.
