Narrative:

The lightning caused Devil's Den fire was discovered on August 16, 2006. On August 17, 2006, at approximately 1445, during initial attack on the fire, one fire fighter died when fire activity increased. The USFS fire was being fought by an interagency crew. The deceased fire fighter is a Bureau of Land Management employee.

On August 18, 2006, a national interagency investigation team is assembling on the Fishlake National Forest/Fillmore District.
