LTC Kevin J. Lambert is a 1993 North Georgia College Distinguished Military graduate. Upon completion of the Infantry Officer Basic Course and Ranger School, he served as a Rifle Platoon Leader, Rifle Company Executive Officer, and Headquarters Company Executive Officer in 2nd Battalion, 87th Infantry, 2nd Brigade, 10th Mountain Division. He also served as a Rifle Platoon Leader and Battalion Civil Affairs Officer in 3d Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment. After attending the Infantry Officer Advanced Course, he served as the assistant Brigade Operations Officer (plans) and as a Rifle Company Commander in the 504th Parachute Infantry Regiment, 1st Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division.

Following company command he earned a Master's Degree in Physical Education from the University of Georgia and was assigned to the United States Military Academy where he served as an instructor and Aide-de-camp to the Superintendent. After completion of the Command General Staff College, he served as the Battalion Operations Officer for 2nd Battalion, 23rd Infantry Regiment (Stryker) and as the Brigade Operations Officer for 4th Brigade, 2nd Infantry Division (Stryker). Most recently he was assigned to the Joint Readiness Training Center where he served as a senior maneuver battalion S3/XO Trainer/Mentor and as the Chief of Plans and Operations.

LTC Lambert's operational deployments include serving in Haiti as a Platoon Leader in support of Operation Uphold Democracy, serving in Kosovo as a Rifle Company Commander in support of Operation Joint Guardian, and serving in Iraq as a Battalion Operations Officer in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

LTC Lambert's awards include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (3OLC), Army Commendation Medal (3 OLC), Army Achievement Medal, and numerous service medals. LTC Lambert has earned the Combat Infantryman's Badge, Expert Infantryman's Badge, Master Parachutist Badge, and Ranger Tab.
