Why the Audit Was Done

Federal law permits the Commission to conduct audits and field investigations of any political committee that is required to file reports under the Federal Election Campaign Act (the Act). The Commission generally conducts such andits when a committee appears not to have met the threshold requirements for substantial compliance with the Act.¹ The audit determines whether the committee complied with the limitations. prohibitions and disclosure roquirements of the Act.

Part I Background

Authority for Audit

This report is based on an audit of the United Food & Commercial Workers International Union, Active Ballot Club (UFCW - ABC), undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission (the Commission) in accordance with the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the Act). The Audit Division conducted the audit pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §438(b), which permits the Commission to conduct audits and field investigations of any political committee that is required to file a report under 2 U.S.C. §434. Prior to conducting any audit under this subsection, the Commission must perform an internal review of reports filed by selected committees to determine if the reports filed by a particular committee racet the threshold requirements for substantial compliance with the Act. 2 U.S.C. §438(b).

Scope of Audit

Following Commission approved procedures, the Audit staff evaluated various risk factors, and as a result, this audit examined:

- 1. The disclosure of disbursements.
- 2. The disclosure of contributors' occupation and name of employer.
- 3. The consistency between reported figures and bank records.
- 4. The completeness of records.
- 5. Other committee operatines necessary to the review.
