# 1 Introduction

This document contains a Reference Guide to the International Shipping Labels APIs. See the Developer's Guide to Web Tools APIs to learn the administrative process for gaining access to the Web Tools APIs as well as the basic mechanism for calling the APIs and processing the results. The Developer's Guide also contains information on testing and trouble-shooting.

For label specifications such as package dimensions, delivery information, etc., please refer to the International Mail Manual (IMM) at <http://pe.usps.com/>.

## 2 Express Mail International API

### 2.1 Express Mail International Request

The table below presents the XML input tags for generating Live requests and the restrictions on the values allowed. An error message will be returned if an incorrect value is entered. Also, be aware of the maximum character amounts allowed for some tags. If the user enters more than those amounts, an error will not be generated. **The Web Tool will simply pass in the characters up to the maximum amount allowed and disregard the rest.** This is important since the resulting value could prevent a correct response.

When building the XML request, pay particular attention to the **order and case** for tags. An error message will be returned if an incorrect value is entered. Remember that all data and attribute values in this document are for illustration purposes and are to be replaced by your actual values. For instance, a line of sample code may be:

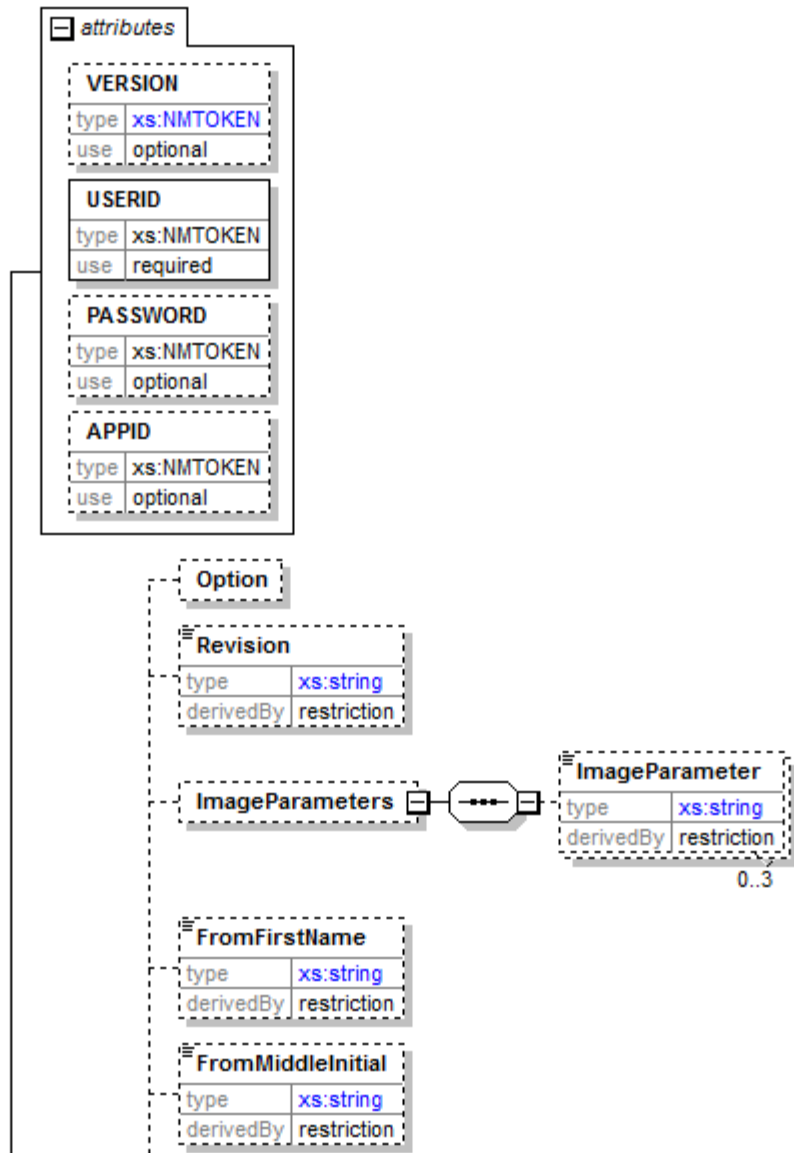

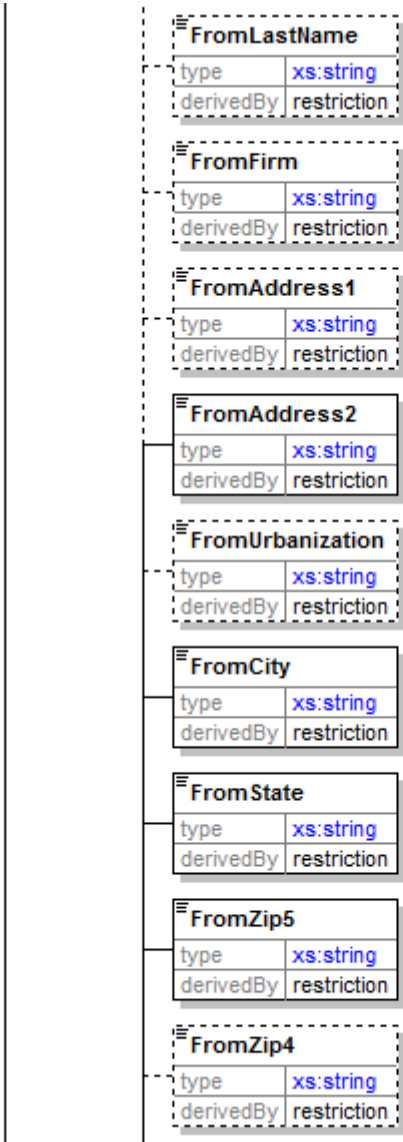
In this instance, you will replace "12345" with the destination ZIP Code for the domestic-bound package.

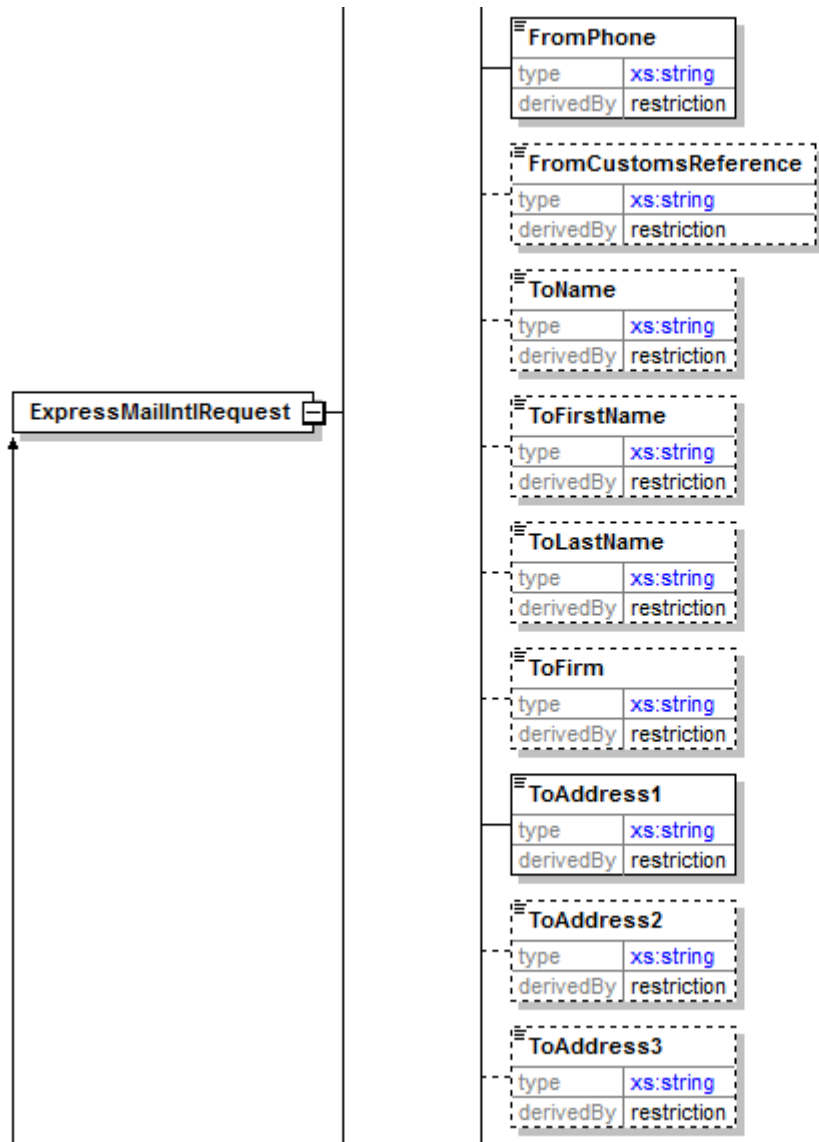



### Express Mail International Service Instructions

1. Shipping supplies are available online at [www.usps.com](http://www.usps.com) or your Local Post Office.
2. Verify that all information populated on each of the copies is valid.
3. Select the appropriate category of the item. If the international shipment contains dangerous goods that are approved for mailing, check the box for "Dangerous Goods." Mailability information for international shipments is available in Publication 52, *Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail* (chapter 6), and in IMM Part 135.
4. Except for shipments to APO/FPO/DPO addresses, enter an Automated Export System (AES) Internal Transaction Number (ITN), AES Exemption, or if applicable, an AES Downtime Citation. This standard may also apply when mailing items to, from, and between U.S. territories, possessions, and Freely Associated States — see DMM 608.2.5. One of these codes must appear in the "AES/ITN/Exemption" block before the Postal Service will accept a package for mailing. In general, mailpieces containing any type of goods (per Schedule B Export Codes at [www.census.gov/foreign-trade/schedules/b/](http://www.census.gov/foreign-trade/schedules/b/)) valued at more than \$2,500, or requiring an export license under U.S. law, must have an ITN issued by the U.S. Census Bureau or an AES Downtime Citation, subject to certain exceptions. Mailpieces that are exempt from filing must have an AES Exemption. Regardless of exemptions, all mailpieces must have an ITN or AES Downtime Citation if they are destined to certain countries on which the U.S. has a comprehensive embargo. To obtain an ITN and file electronically through the Census Bureau's AES, or for additional information, please visit [www.census.gov/foreign-trade/ae](http://www.census.gov/foreign-trade/ae)s or call 800-549-0595. For additional information, refer to U.S. Postal Service® Publication 699, *Special Requirements for Shipping Internationally*, and to IMM Part 520.

**AES Exemption.** In order to comply with U.S. Census Bureau's Foreign Trade Regulations, indicate "NOEEI § 30.37(a)," if applicable. "NOEEI § 30.37(a)" may be used when the value of each class of goods is \$2,500 or less, if an export license is not required. 5. Commercial senders: supply the following information to assist Customs in processing the items.
  - a. Enter, if known, the 6-digit Harmonized Tariff Schedule number, which is based on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System developed by the World Customs Organization. "Country of Origin" means the country where the goods originated - i.e., where they were produced/manufactured or assembled.
  - b. Enter License, Certificate, and/or Invoice number, if applicable.
6. Fold or cut all copies in half and arrange in numerical order with "1-Customs Declaration" copy on top. Copies must be placed into the PS Form 2976-E, *Customs Declaration Envelope - CP 91* (plastic envelope).
  - a. Affix the plastic envelope to the package on the address side.
  - b. Package must be large enough that the plastic envelope does not wrap around the package edges.
  - c. Ensure that the entire barcode and all information is visible.
  - d. If using a pickup service, retain Sender's Copy then arrange remaining copies in numerical order with "1-Customs Declaration" copy on top.
7. Express Mail International items bearing a computer-generated customs form with customs data that has been electronically transmitted (e.g., using Click-N-Ship service) may be deposited through any of the following methods, provided postage is paid by a means other than the use of postage stamps: (a) through Package Pickup Service; (b) At a Postal Service retail counter; (c) Into a Postal Service lobby drop; (d) In a collection box; (e) At a Contract Postal Unit (CPU). For additional places of mailing, see IMM Part 225. Items must be mailed on the mailing date selected.
8. Each shipping label number is unique and can be used only once - **DO NOT PHOTOCOPY or FAX - ONLY THE ORIGINAL LABEL CAN BE ACCEPTED.**

**PARCEL INDEMNITY COVERAGE:** Indemnity for Express Mail International® parcels, including insured and ordinary (uninsured) parcels, is provided only in accordance with Postal Service™ regulations in the Domestic Mail Manual (DMM®) and the International Mail Manual (IMM®). The DMM and IMM are available online at <http://pe.usps.com>. The addressee must report damage or missing contents to the delivering Post Office™ immediately.

Insurance purchased online cannot be combined with additional insurance purchased at the Post Office. Insured mail service is available for a fee and replaces indemnity on ordinary parcels. Insurance coverage varies by country and is not available to some countries. Indemnity coverage is subject to both U.S. Postal Service® regulations and the domestic regulations of the destination country. Insurance for loss, damage, or missing contents covers the actual (depreciated) value of the contents.

**FILING CLAIMS:** To initiate an inquiry for loss, damage, or missing contents, call the International Inquiry Center at 800-222-1811. **EXCEPTIONS:** No coverage is provided for consequential losses, delay, concealed damage, spoilage of perishable items, articles improperly packaged, articles too fragile to withstand normal handling in the mails, or prohibited articles. ## 3 Priority Mail International API

### 3.1 Priority Mail International Request

The table below presents the XML input tags for generating Live requests and the restrictions on the values allowed. An error message will be returned if an incorrect value is entered. Also, be aware of the maximum character amounts allowed for some tags. If the user enters more than those amounts, an error will not be generated. **The Web Tool will simply pass in the characters up to the maximum amount allowed and disregard the rest.** This is important since the resulting value could prevent a correct response.

When building the XML request, pay particular attention to the **order and case** for tags. An error message will be returned if an incorrect value is entered. Remember that all data and attribute values in this document are for illustration purposes and are to be replaced by your actual values. For instance, a line of sample code may be:

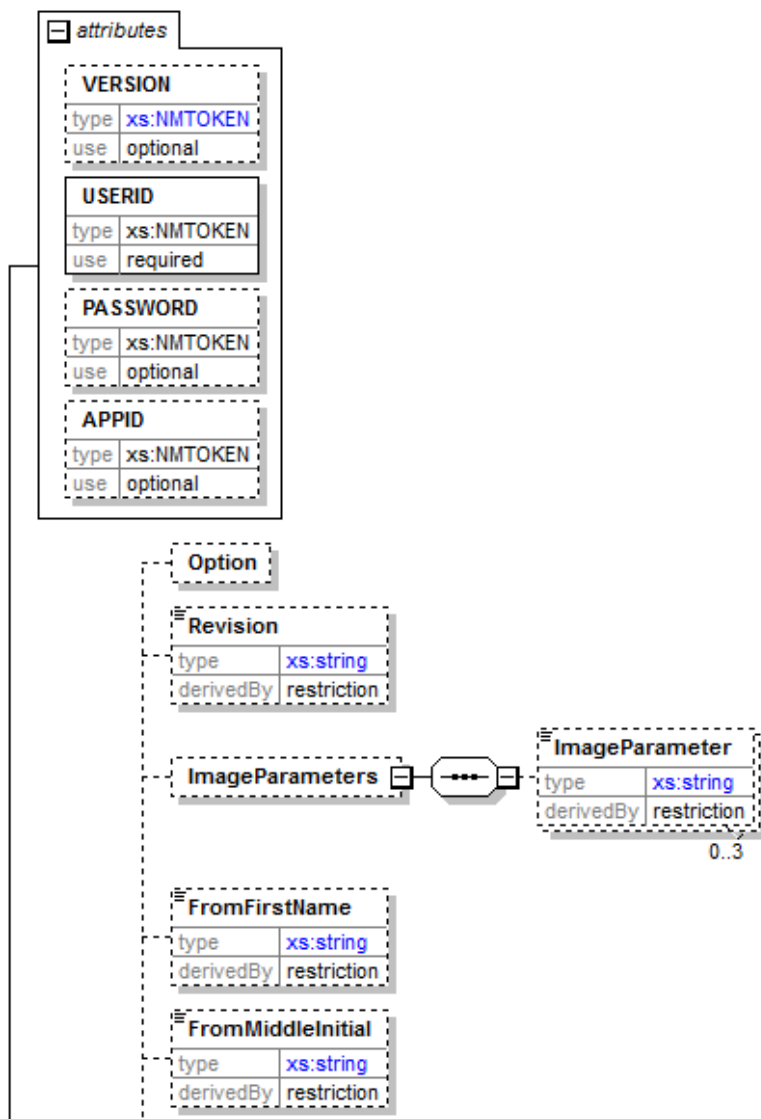

## Priority Mail International Service Instructions

### Priority Mail International - Terms and Conditions (Indemnity)

Indemnity for Priority Mail International® parcels, including insured and ordinary (uninsured) parcels, is provided only in accordance with Postal Service™ regulations in the *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM®) and the *International Mail Manual* (IMM®). The DMM and IMM are available online at [pe.usps.com](http://pe.usps.com). The addressee must report damage or missing contents to the delivering Post Office™ immediately.

Ordinary (uninsured) Priority Mail International parcels include indemnity coverage against loss, damage, or missing contents. Indemnity is limited to the lesser of the actual value of the contents or the maximum indemnity based on the weight of the article. Priority Mail International Flat Rate Envelopes and Priority Mail International Small Flat Rate Boxes are letter-post items and do not include indemnity coverage.

Indemnity coverage is subject to both U.S. Postal Service® regulations and the domestic regulations of the destination country. Based on weight, indemnity coverage may be included at no additional charge, and may not be available to some countries. Indemnity for loss, damage, or missing contents is limited to the lesser of the actual value of the contents or the maximum indemnity based on the weight of the article. Claims for damage and loss may be payable only to addressee; indemnity is not paid for valuable or prohibited articles. No coverage is provided for consequential losses, delay, concealed damage, spoilage or perishable items, articles improperly packaged, articles too fragile to withstand normal handling in the mails or prohibited articles. See the DMM and the IMM for the specific types of losses that are covered, the limitations on coverage and conditions of payment. International insurance coverage greater than the indemnity limits for uninsured parcels is available for an additional fee. Refer to IMM Part 232 for additional information.

### Priority Mail International - Terms and Conditions (Insurance)

International insurance coverage is available for Priority Mail International® flat rate and variable weight parcels and is subject to both U.S. Postal Service® regulations and the domestic regulations of the destination country. Insurance coverage varies by country and is not available to some countries. Any article received in damaged condition or with some or all contents missing must be taken to any Post Office for inspection. All claims for damage or missing contents must be filed immediately, and the article, containers, packaging, and all contents received must be presented to the destination Post Office. Further information is available in IMM Part 232.

*Note: Indemnity and Insurance are not available for the Priority Mail International Flat Rate Envelope and small flat-rate box.*

1. Shipping supplies are available online at [www.usps.com](http://www.usps.com) or your Local Post Office.

2. Verify that all information populated on each of the copies is valid.

3. Select the appropriate category of the item. If the international shipment contains dangerous goods that are approved for mailing, check the box for "Dangerous Goods." Mailability information for international shipments is available in Publication 52, *Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail* (chapter 6), and in IMM Part 135.

4. Except for shipments to APO/FPO/DPO addresses, enter an Automated Export System (AES) Internal Transaction Number (ITN), AES Exemption, or if applicable, an AES Downtime Citation. This standard may also apply when mailing items to, from, and between U.S. territories, possessions, and Freely Associated States — see DMM 608.2.5. One of these codes must appear in the "AES/ITN/Exemption" block before the Postal Service will accept a package for mailing. In general, mailpieces containing any type of goods (per Schedule B Export Codes at [www.census.gov/foreign-trade/schedules/b](http://www.census.gov/foreign-trade/schedules/b)) valued at more than \$2,500, or requiring an export license under U.S. law, must have an ITN issued by the U.S. Census Bureau or an AES Downtime Citation, subject to certain exceptions. Mailpieces that are exempt from filing must have an AES Exemption. Regardless of exemptions, all mailpieces must have an ITN or AES Downtime Citation if they are destined to certain countries on which the U.S. has a comprehensive embargo. To obtain an ITN and file electronically through the Census Bureau's AES, or for additional information, please visit [www.census.gov/foreign-trade/aes](http://www.census.gov/foreign-trade/aes) or call 800-549-0595. 5. Commercial senders: supply the following information to assist Customs in processing the items.

- a. Enter, if known, the 6-digit Harmonized Tariff Schedule number, which is based on the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System developed by the World Customs Organization. "Country of Origin" means the country where the goods originated - i.e., where they were produced/manufactured or assembled.
- b. Enter License, Certificate, and/or Invoice number, if applicable.

6. Fold or cut all copies in half and arrange in numerical order with "1-Customs Declaration" copy on top. Copies must be placed into the PS Form 2976-E, *Customs Declaration Envelope - CP 91* (plastic envelope).

- a. Affix the plastic envelope to the package on the address side.
- b. Package must be large enough that the plastic envelope does not wrap around the package edges.
- c. Ensure that the entire barcode and all information is visible.
- d. If using a pickup service, retain Sender's Copy then arrange remaining copies in numerical order with "1-Customs Declaration" copy on top

7. Priority Mail International items bearing a computer-generated customs form with customs data that has been electronically transmitted (e.g., using Click-N-Ship service) may be deposited through any of the following methods, provided postage is paid by a means other than the use of postage stamps: (a) through Package Pickup Service; (b) At a Postal Service retail counter; (c) Into a Postal Service lobby drop; (d) In a collection box; (e) At a Contract Postal Unit (CPU). For additional places of mailing, see IMM Part 235. Items must be mailed on the mailing date selected.

## 4 First Class Mail International API

### 4.1 First Class Mail International Request

The table below presents the XML input tags for generating Live requests and the restrictions on the values allowed. An error message will be returned if an incorrect value is entered. Also, be aware of the maximum character amounts allowed for some tags. If the user enters more than those amounts, an error will not be generated. **The Web Tool will simply pass in the characters up to the maximum amount allowed and disregard the rest.** This is important since the resulting value could prevent a correct response.

When building the XML request, pay particular attention to the **order and case** for tags. An error message will be returned if an incorrect value is entered. Remember that all data and attribute values in this document are for illustration purposes and are to be replaced by your actual values. For instance, a line of sample code may be:

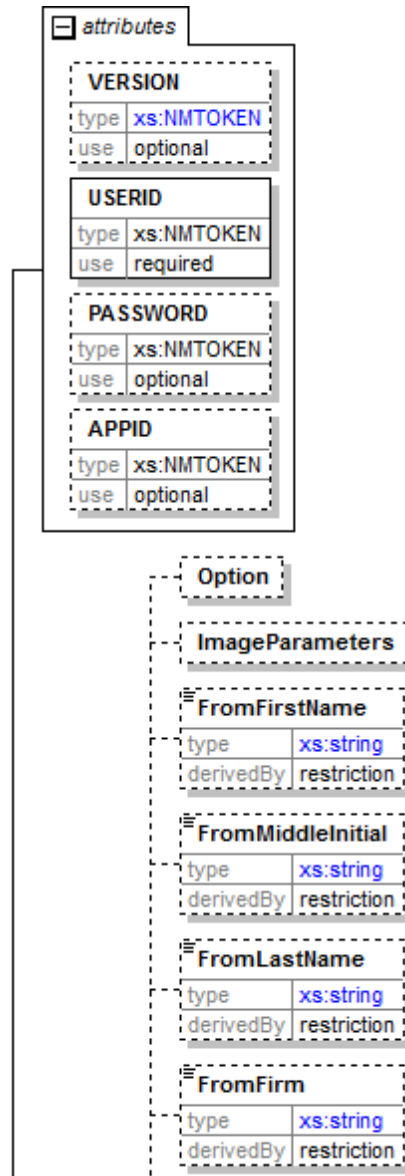
