LTC Jeffrey Anderson was born and grew up in the Piedmont of North Carolina. He attended the United States Military Academy at West Point and graduated in 1993 with a degree in History. After completing the Officer Basic Course at Fort Sill, OK, he was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division at Fort Bragg from 1994-1997. While at Fort Bragg, he served as Company Fire Support Officer for 2-504 PIR, Charlie Battery Fire Direction Officer, Battalion Adjutant and Intelligence Officer for 3-319 AFAR. After another short stint back at Fort Sill for the FA Advanced Course where he graduated as a Master Warfighter, LTC Anderson joined the Big Red One in Germany. While in Germany, he served as the DIVARTY Assistant S3 and Battery Commander in 1-6 FA.
