2013 NAEP TESTING

On February 27 and 28, our 4th and 8th grade students are scheduled to participate in the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), commonly known as the Nation's Report Card. A letter concerning NAEP participation will be sent home with all 4th and 8th grade students on

February 13. NAEP is sponsored by the U.S. Department of Education and is designed to test what students know and can do in subjects commonly taught in school. The results from this will be used to help the Department of Defense maintain high quality schools for military dependents. It will take about 90 minutes for most students to complete NAEP. Results are reported at the state level, for DoDEA as a whole and will not affect the student's grades in school by participating.
