Pursuant to FMR Bulletin B-30, NARA has performed the required evaluation of the vehicle fleet and developed a plan to optimize the fleet by 2015. NARA is a small federal agency that is comprised of 13 Presidential Libraries and 28 Federal Record and Archival Research Centers. While each of these unique organizations within NARA has a special mission, the agency as a whole has been challenged to serve American democracy by safeguarding and preserving the records of our Government, ensuring that the people can discover, use, and learn from this documentary heritage. In order to fulfill the individual organization missions and the overall agency mission, NARA has a need for all types of vehicles from sedans to heavy trucks throughout the nation.

During FY11 the NARA fleet was comprised of 76 GSA Fleet leased vehicles. Currently the list of vehicles leased by NARA includes: sedans, multi-purpose vehicles, along with medium and heavy duty vehicles. NARA currently leases 22 vehicles that generate revenue for the agency. Additionally, NARA provides courier services in the National Capital Region and requires the use of Government owned vehicles to transport holdings, records, and artifacts maintained at any NARA site.

NARA has used this opportunity to evaluate each vehicle in the fleet and develop a plan that combines current commitments with future growth plans. The current estimation should have the NARA fleet at 66 vehicles by 2015. This plan takes into account the increase in Federal Record Centers and Presidential Libraries expected by 2015. Also included is the reassignment of vehicles to sites that presently have no assigned vehicle but, due to NARA policy, require a GOV to transport government holdings and records.

This summarization also addresses NARA's plan to assure all light duty vehicles leased by 2015 will be alternative fueled vehicles. Currently most of the light duty fleet vehicles are AFV's (E85). The biggest challenge NARA faces is that vehicles are stationed throughout the country and most areas have no access to alternative fuels. NARA has no fueling stations and has no plans to install fuel pumps at any location. NARA's transportation department has identified sites throughout the country that may benefit from hybrid and electric vehicle technology and will work with GSA to replace the current fleet with these vehicles. The biggest challenge to NARA acquiring these vehicles by 2015 is the limited vehicle funding available for both NARA and GSA.

Site Missions

HQ:

NARA headquarters has an active motorpool operation that is charged with providing scheduled daily courier and mail services for all organizations at A1, A2 and various federal agencies in Metropolitan DC. The motorpool also maintains a fleet of vehicles to transport senior officials, transport records between multiple facilities, pick up and deliver other Executive Agency records, and manage and schedule vehicles to conduct routine government business by employees of all organizations within A2. The motorpool at A2 currently works with A1 to schedule, manage, and make available vehicles at the A1 site.

Approved vehicles: MPVs; passenger vans; cargo vans; HD trucks

A1:

A1 has an active motorpool for the multitude of organizations onsite. These vehicles are primarily used to transport people and records to other local agencies.

Approved vehicles: MPVs; cargo vans

A1-Presidential Materials:

This unit has a van assigned for the exclusive use of PM. The vehicle is required to provide courtesy storage and retrieval of Presidential records and materials. This has a unique mission that requires immediate response.

Approved vehicles: MPVs; cargo vans

A1-Legislative Archives:

This unit is much like PM except they require use of a vehicle for storage and retrieval of legislative records for members of the House and the Senate.

Approved vehicles: MPVs; cargo vans

FRC:

The FRC's have responsibility for maintaining, storing, and referencing records for federal agencies. The FRC's provide "fee for service" operations including Metro Courier, Fast Packs, and records digitization services

Approved vehicles: MPVs; cargo vans; HD Trucks

Records Management:

This group provides technical assistance, information, and guidance on federal records management policies and regulations. RM staff evaluates and provides technical assistance and training on records management programs for federal agencies.

Approved vehicles: MPVs; occasionally sedans

Archival Center:

These are a repository for archival records. They are responsible for preserving and making available to the public through education, public programs, and exhibits.

Approved: MPVs; occasionally sedans

Library:

The Libraries preserve and make available records, artifacts, and other historical materials for the last 13 Presidents. Each serves the community through education, preservation, interpretation, and promotion of the President's life and service to the country.

Approved: MPVs

Replacement Vehicles:

Sedans:

Use of sedans should be limited. The sites should be urged to use POVs. Many sites have stated they require GOVs to reduce the cost of long distance and local travel. The claim is that using a GOV for long distance travel eases the burden of ever shrinking travel budgets and that using a POV is an expensive proposition due to the mileage reimbursement requirement.

Sedans should be limited to subcompact (SIN 8C). These are the cheapest and most fuel efficient vehicles and have the lowest GHG score. NARA could allow the larger compact vehicle, Malibu (SIN 9C), to be leased providing the site purchased E85 fuel at all times. The GHG score for this vehicle, operating only on E85, is 6.

Multipurpose vehicles:

Most sites will find these to be the most useful vehicle. This vehicle type can transport large numbers of passengers or large quantities of cargo (SIN 20).

An alternative to the MPV would be a crossover (SIN 91B).

Passenger Vans:

Certain sites do have a necessity for large passenger vans. 12 and 15 passenger vans are acceptable under certain circumstances (e.g. shuttles or larger NARA sites with a number of employees)

Cargo vans:

GSA has evaluated how NARA uses cargo vans and has suggested the Agency lease the E350 (SIN 94B) as the standard vehicle when organizations require a cargo van. This vehicle would provide the proper payload capacity for Metro Courier van services. The current fleet contains vehicles that are operated in an unsafe manner because they are overweight or over capacity. Standard equipment should include a cargo cage.

Box Trucks:

GSA has evaluated how NARA uses box trucks and has suggested the Agency lease box trucks (SIN 571) and request smaller boxes with a shorter wheel base. This will provide the capacity required by most FRC's. This style vehicle does not require the driver to hold a CDL. Options suggested are:

- Rail lift gate (requires less maintenance than a scissor lift)
- HD Floor
- Translucent roof
- Scale inside truck
- Dual driver seat
- Tilt steering
- Heated remote mirrors
- Auto traction
- Side door

Some FRC's can acquire larger box trucks as they have drivers with CDLs.

There are other vehicles that NARA has in the fleet. These vehicles should be reviewed as they are replaced to see if the capacity, load levels, etc., match the NARA usage.

NARA is currently reviewing how hybrid and electric vehicles could be used to meet the agency's missions.

4) National Archives and Records Administration Plan for Alternative Fuel Vehicle Acquisition

NARA currently leases all fleet vehicles from GSA. To date, GSA has provided NARA with only E85 vehicles as the alternative fuel vehicle of choice. NARA is in the process of evaluating what role hybrid vehicles will play in the NARA fleet and at what locations will they provide the best value to the Agency. Due to the additional costs, leasing hybrid vehicles from GSA Fleet will require NARA to reevaluate current vehicle budgets. While implementing the Fleet Optimization Plan will reduce the size of the fleet, the acquisition of alternative fueled vehicles will reduce the realized savings due to the additional costs of the hybrid technology.

NARA has also identified three opportunities to replace inefficient petroleum fueled vehicles with electric vehicles. NARA will work with GSA, over the next three years, to either lease or purchase these vehicles. This change to electric vehicle will require infrastructure changes and is incumbent upon adequate funding for this program.

5) National Archives and Records Administration Plan for Fueling Alterative Fueled Vehicles

NARA has identified 28 alternative fueled vehicles (E85) within the fleet that are currently located within 5 miles of E85 fueling stations. NARA's local fleet managers have been informed that they must purchase E85 fuel for their assigned vehicles. NARA's transportation department monitors the purchase of E85 to ensure the fueling requirements are being met and is aware that this fuel is not always available at the listed retail locations. NARA will continue to lobby GSA to gain access to and have the GSA-NARA fleet fuel cards accepted at NASA-Greenbelt, Andrews Air Force Base, and Bolling Air Force Base.

NARA has an additional 20 alternative fueled vehicles (E85) that are not located within 5 miles of an E85 fueling station. It has been requested of NARA local fleet managers that they purchase E85 fuel when it is available. These vehicles are evaluated on a continual basis to see if a different AFV would be practicable at that site.

6) Vehicle Sourcing

The National Archives and Records Administration currently leases 74 vehicles from GSA fleet. Leasing vehicles through GSA provides NARA with:

- Fuel card services:
- Vehicle reporting capability that fulfills the FMR Bulletin B-15 requirement;
- Vehicle maintenance

Since NARA is small agency with few resources to devote to the management of a national vehicle program it would not be cost effective to purchase or commercially lease vehicles. The purchase or lease of vehicles would require NARA to create and fund vehicle maintenance contracts; develop and implement a vehicle information system that would be capable of downloading data into FAST; and manage a fleet fuel card program and/or manage onsite fueling stations. Additionally, NARA would have to task onsite fleet personnel with additional duties to maintain an internal fleet program.

The costs to create this in-house program to manage vehicles as opposed to using GSA Fleet leasing would far exceed any benefit. Therefore, it is in NARA's best interest to continue to lease vehicles through GSA Fleet.
