CANDIDATE CRITERIA:

- Applicant must live in the 5th Congressional District of Alabama
- Applicant must meet all Academy requirements
- Applicant must be at least 17 years old, and not have passed their 23rd birthday by July 1 of the year of entry to the Military, Naval or Air Force Academies and have not passed their 25th birthday for the Merchant Marine Academy
- Applicant must be unmarried, not be pregnant, and have no legal obligation for support to children or other dependents
- Applicant must be a United States Citizen by the Congressional Nomination application deadline date

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICATION FOR CONGRESSIONAL NOMINATION

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

Applicants for Congressional Nomination for the **Class of 2016** must submit the **CONGRESSIONAL NOMINATION FORM** and other **required documents** (see checklist) by Tuesday, **November 15**, **2011** to:

CANDIDATE INTERVIEWS

All required documents must be received or postmarked no later than November 15, 2011 to complete each applicant's Academy file. Applicants with a complete file will be scheduled for an interview in late November /early December. Eligible applicants will be notified of the date and time of their interview.

NOMINATIONS AND APPOINTMENTS (Class of 2016)

A member of Congress may nominate up to ten applicants per vacancy and is not permitted to have more than five men or women in each Academy at one time. Generally, a vacancy is created only by graduation. A nomination by Congressman Brooks does not guarantee an appointment to an academy.

Congressman Brooks has established a nominating committee. The committee will review applications, interview prospective candidates and make final selection of Alabama District 5 nominees to be submitted to the Academies. Nominations are based on a "whole person" evaluation. Factors such as academic achievement, extracurricular activities, leadership skills, physical aptitude, character and motivation are taken into consideration and compared with other applicants. Nominations will be determined using the competitive method with all nominees submitted unranked to the Academies, allowing equal opportunity for each candidate nominated from the district.

Academies will begin to notify candidates of their admission status in February 2012. All offers of appointment are generally sent out by May 2012.

REMINDERS

- EACH ACADEMY HAS ITS OWN SELECTION PROCESS FOR ADMITTANCE. APPLICANTS MUST COMPLETE THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR EACH ACADEMY THAT THEY ARE CONSIDERING ATTENDING.
- TO BETTER THEIR CHANCES OF OBTAINING A NOMINATION, AN APPLICANT MAY WISH TO SEND AN APPLICATION FOR NOMINATION TO EACH OF OUR U.S. SENATORS AND TO THE VICE PRESIDENT. VISIT THEIR WEBSITES FOR DETAILS.

Official transcripts from your most recent high school and, if applicable, college.

□ SAT / ACT SCORES

Official scores from the testing agency. When you register to take the test (s) use Code 1226 for the SAT and Code 7215 for the ACT, and your scores will be mailed directly to our Huntsville office from testing agency.

■ LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Three (3) letters of recommendation from adult non-family members, for example, teachers, counselors, employers, coaches, clergy, and scout leaders.

ESSAY

500-word essay describing why you are interested in attending a service academy.

☐ RESUME

Current resume; include extracurricular activities, leadership positions, academic and athletic accomplishments, and other relevant awards and distinctions.

□ RECENT WALLET-SIZED PHOTO

All documents must be received or **postmarked no later than November 15, 2011** to complete each applicant's academy file. Please mail documents to:
