Indian Bayou Physically Challenged ATV Trail Closure

PORT BARRE – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Atchafalaya Basin Floodway System (ABFS) Project Office has closed a physically challenged ATV trail throughout the 2007-08 hunting season.

The closed trail is located in the southern portion of Section 27 and the northern portion of Section 34 of Township 7 South, Range 7 East in St. Landry Parish, otherwise located as extending south of the main ATV trail from the Dixie Pipeline.

This closure will assist with needed maintenance work and will also help to reduce the likelihood of future closures.

All other trails on Indian Bayou will remain open to the public. Physically challenged ATV trails are open only to those individuals in possession of their state permits and to individuals over the age of 60.
