## **Corps to meet with London Canal homeowners**

They will learn why, when and where trees will be removed

**What.** Public meeting for the Corps of Engineers to present its plans to remove trees in the levee section and those within six feet of the levee toe on the London Avenue Canal, from its head at Pump Station 3 to Robert E. Lee Blvd.

When. Wednesday, Oct. 25, 2006, from 6:30 to 8 p.m.

Where. University of New Orleans, Old Business Building, Room 165.

**Who should attend.** Owners (or their representatives) with property adjacent to the east and west banks of the London Avenue Canal.

**Why remove.** To protect the London Avenue Canal floodwalls and adjoining neighborhoods during high water stages in the canal.

**Program elements.** Review of current conditions and why trees will be removed. Plan and schedule. Near-term outlook for London canal in light of interim gates and pumps being in place. Future of canal relative to construction of permanent gates and pumps.
