Local project update

100 year hurricane and storm damage reduction actions

The New Orleans District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is continuing the series of public meetings with three meetings in the month of September. Meetings will focus on 100 year hurricane protection projects in Orleans Parish and on the West Bank, Harvey – Westwego areas of Jefferson Parish. Corps staff will provide updates on the construction projects and environmental compliance in these areas and be available to answer questions on the proposed 100-year hurricane protection plan.
