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Meeting Thursday on big hurricane project Magnitude of Construction over \$500 million

Prospective contractors, subcontractors encouraged to attend

NEW ORLEANS—The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will host a Phase One Project Information Meeting for the Inner Harbor Navigation Canal Hurricane Protection Project for Phase One submittal process on Thursday for contractors, subcontractors and small businesses to learn about opportunities to participate in a multi-million dollar contract.

The meeting is set Thursday, July 12, from 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. It will be held in the District Assembly Room (DARM A), New Orleans District, at 7400 Leake Avenue, New Orleans.

The scope of work includes all architectural, engineering, construction, project management, quality control, and other related services to design and construct a line of defense that will provide protection for surges produced by a 100-year hurricane.

Corps of Engineers officials will give a summary of the project and provide an opportunity for questions and concerns. This is an unrestricted procurement, Solicitation No. W912P8-07-R-0053, for the Inner Harbor Navigation Canal Hurricane Protection Project, magnitude of construction is over \$500 million.
