Miss. River Commission to visit La., Aug. 24

Corps of Engineers invites public to give views and comments

NEW ORLEANS—Want to share your ideas with the Army Corps of Engineers? Ask questions about projects?

Here's your chance, a public meeting of the Mississippi River Commission aboard of the Motor Vessel Mississippi at Morgan City on Friday, Aug. 24.

The commission's seven members' unusual degree of independence springs from their being nominated by the president and confirmed by the Senate, said Col. Alvin B. "Al" Lee, commander of the New Orleans District.

"Under the law, the members advise the Corps' chief of engineers and the secretary of the Army," Lee said. "Accordingly, they are well positioned to speak frankly and to forward your questions and ideas up the line."

The public meeting begins at 9 a.m. on the MV *Mississippi*, a 241-foot Corps towboat at the <u>Port of Morgan City</u> wharf, 800 Youngs Road.

The Louisiana public meeting will conclude the 2007 Low-Water Inspection Trip, which began Aug. 17 in St. Louis. All public meeting proceedings, including citizens' statements and members' responses, are stenographically recorded and available to the public.

The Mississippi River Commission is responsible for the basin's three great rivers and the commission includes three Corps generals: Brig. Gen. Robert Crear, the commission president and Mississippi Valley Division commander; Brig. Gen. Bruce A. Berwick, commander of the Great Lakes and Ohio River Division, and Brig. Gen. Gregg F. Martin, commander of the Northwestern Division (Missouri River).
