SUBJECT: Request for Information Concerning Future Clean Air Act
Rules of Significance to Department of Energy Operations

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you of the release of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Fall 2009 Regulatory Agenda and to request your input on the proposed Clean Air Act (CAA) rules of most significance to Department of Energy (DOE) operations.

On December 7, 2009, EPA published its "Fall 2009 Semi-Annual Regulatory Agenda" to update the public and regulated entities about environmental regulations and major policies under development, reviews and schedules of existing regulations, and rules and major policy-makings completed or cancelled since the last agenda.

One of the responsibilities of the Office of Health, Safety and Security: Office of Environmental Policy and Assistance is to engage with EPA on environmental regulations and operational issues concerning DOE sites. To support this responsibility, the Office of Environmental Policy and Assistance requests you review this Regulatory Agenda to identify the air quality regulations of the most importance to DOE sites and organizations. A summary of the Regulatory Agenda is provided in Attachment A and available at <http://www.reginfo.gov/public/do/eAgendaMain>. Please review the attached EPA CAA pre-rule actions and proposed rules, (Tables A-1 and A-2 in Attachment A), and submit a list of the items most significant to your site or organization using the form in Attachment B to Mr. Larry Stirling (john.stirling@hq.doe.gov; 202-586-2417) by January 8, 2010. Your input will enable the Office of Health, Safety and Security to prioritize its resources and focus on those items most likely to affect DOE site operations.

Thank you in advance for providing your perspective on clean air regulatory-related activities of most importance to your site operations and for your continued interest and participation in our Clean Air Working Group.
