

Who is Qualified?

- SABIT wants a mid- to senior-level industry professional who is in a position make applicable changes in his/her company based on what he/she saw while on the SABIT program and is motivated to make them.
- In general, SABIT looks for a professional with at least 5 years' experience in his/her industry and an educational background in that industry as well.

Some Tips on Applying:

SABIT looks for applications in which all the questions are answered and the applicant's goal is clearly specified.

The program is designed for the individual participants. If you are ultimately selected, your application is used to develop the meetings and training that will be most useful to you.

SABIT prefers that applications be completed in Russian and then translated into English, so that if there is a question about the English answer, it can be compared to the Russian version.
