

Army in Europe Retiree Council RETIREEINFO List

What is the RETIREEINFO List?

RETIREEINFO is a “one-way” e-mail program list used only to disseminate a single message simultaneously to a group of individual subscribers. This program, operated by the Army in Europe Retiree Council, is hosted on an official HQ USAREUR computer administered by HQ USAREUR DCSG6. The Retiree Council uses it to send to subscribing US military retirees in Europe only official material of interest such as the IMCOM-Europe Retiree Bulletin, minutes of the Army in Europe Retiree Council and other pertinent announcements. RETIREEINFO does not share its e-mail addresses.

How to Subscribe to RETIREEINFO:

- If you have a military e-mail account, such as AKO, use this account to send the following message:

TO: LISTSERV@LISTSERV.HQUSAREUR.ARMY.MIL

Subject: *Can leave blank.*

Message text: (have no text in front of the following!)

```
SUBSCRIBE RETIREEINFO <yourfirstname> <yourlastname>  
<yourUSAG>  
END
```

That's all there is to it.

- If you do *not* have a military e-mail account:

Alternative 1: Ask your local RSO to request your non-military email address be added to the RETIREEINFO subscriber list.

Alternative 2: Obtain a military email account easily from Army Knowledge on Line (AKO) (or from your own service). Ask your Retirement Services Officer (RSO) how retirees *and their family members* can obtain AKO e-mail accounts. Then subscribe to RETIREEINFO from that email account.

Unsubscribing from RETIREEINFO: You can “unsubscribe” (SIGNOFF) from RETIREEINFO whenever you wish. Instructions are provided in each posting to the list.
