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George Washington Memorial Parkway's Exit ramp southbound I-395 will close for two to three days

McLean, VA - As part of the ongoing Humpback Bridge Replacement Project the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Eastern Federal Lands Highways Division (EFLHD), in cooperation with the National Park Service (NPS), will temporarily close the exit ramp to I-395 South only for three days beginning on or about May 10, 2011 between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. This exit is located immediately after the bridge off the southbound lanes of the Parkway. Boundary Channel Bridge (Humpback bridge) is located on the George Washington Memorial Parkway (GWMP) just north of Interstate 395 and immediately south of the Columbia Island Marina.

This temporary closure of the exit ramp is necessary to complete the storm drain work on the southwest side of the bridge. Construction crews will work from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. daily. Expect delays.

Drivers may notice an increase in brief closures not lasting longer than 15 minutes to allow truck traffic safe passage. During construction, one lane in each direction will remain open at all times except for the brief fifteen minute delivery delays. Please use caution when commuting through the construction area. Drivers are encouraged to use suggested alternate routes (see below). Variable electronic message boards and construction signs have been and will remain in place to alert drivers of the expected closures.

All lanes of the GWMP and the Humpback Bridge will remain open during rush hours, or from 5:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Delays can be expected when construction crews will work between 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and from 7:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

The planned completion date for all work is currently scheduled for late spring 2011. Weather delays may require adjustments to the schedule. The FHWA and the NPS will continue to inform the public and the media of any changes in the work schedule. The FHWA and the NPS regret any inconvenience and appreciate the public's understanding.

For your convenience, the FHWA and the NPS again provide the following suggested alternate route during this construction project:

Alternate Route from points north to Cristal City:

- 1. Take GWMP South and exit at Arlington Cemetery/Memorial Bridge.
- 2. Turn left onto Memorial Avenue.
- 3. Take exit ramp on right to South 1/110.
- 4. Merge onto 110 South.

Drivers using exit ramp to I-395 South

1. Take the previous exit to Route 27 and then I-395 South

From points north to National Airport and points south:

- 1. Take GWMP South and exit at Arlington Cemetery/Memorial Bridge.
- 2. Turn left onto Memorial Avenue.
- 3. Take exit ramp on right to South 1/110.
- 4. Merge onto 110 South.
- 5. Take the I-395 North/US-1 North ramp.
- 6. Take exit 10 A-B for GWMP South toward Reagan National Airport.
- 7. Merge onto GWMP South.

From Columbia Island Marina to South I-395:

Take GWMP South and take the second exit to Regan National Airport

- 1. Cross the bridge over GWMP, take the second exit on your right and loop back into GWMP northbound
- 2. Take exit to I-395 South
