

Homework Policy

The purpose of homework is to reinforce classroom instruction. Effective homework assignments accommodate different learning rates. Homework promotes self-discipline and allows teachers an additional opportunity to monitor student progress.

Parent involvement in homework supports learning and helps parents understand how their children are progressing in school.

Homework hours suggested for students at each grade level follow:

Grades	Homework week hours	At four nights a week
PreK-K	1-1 1/2	15 minutes
1	2-4	30-40 minutes
2	2-4	30-45 minutes

All homework requirements include 15 minutes (10 for PreK-K) of reading aloud or silent reading.

Parents' Responsibilities Regarding Their Student's Homework

Parents are encouraged to provide an environment which fosters the development of life-long learning skills.

This includes:

- A quiet place to work.
- Necessary materials.
- A regular study time.
- Encouragement and praise.
