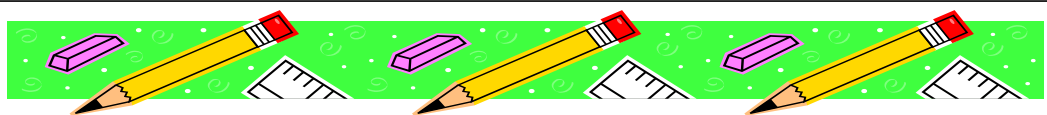

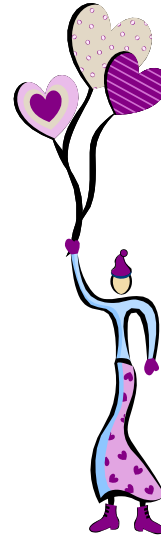

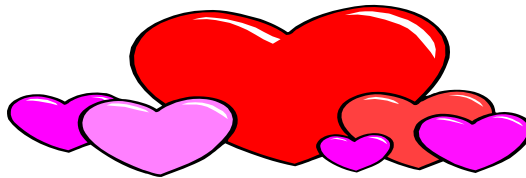

Dress Code: Fort Campbell Elementary Schools (FCES) (Grades Pre-K – 5)

Fort Campbell elementary school students take pride in being neatly groomed and fashion-conscious. However, they should always be dressed appropriately for the school environment.
