A MESSAGE FROM OUR SCHOOL NURSE

Children aged 6 months through 8n years need a 2<sup>nd</sup> dose of flu vaccine in 2012+2013 (Oct-Apr) if any of the following apply to your child:

- If they did not receive the flu vaccine during both 2011-2012 (Oct-Apr), and 2010-11 (Oct-Apr) flu seasons.
- If they did not receive at least 2 doses of seasonal flu vaccine in addition to at least 1 dose of H1N1 vaccine before July 2010

If your child received flu vaccine at school in October 2012, your child is now eligible to receive their 2<sup>nd</sup> flu vaccine dose if the above applies. Appointments should be scheduled with their primary care provider to receive this 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. This is important to further reduce the risk of your child becoming infected with the flu virus.

#### What is Child Find?

Child Find is a Ft. Campbell Schools action devoted to locating and identifying children who may have a Developmental delay or identified Educational disabilities. The age range for these children is birth through 21 years old.



#### Dress Code: Fort Campbell Elementary Schools (FCES) (Grades Pre-K – 5)

Fort Campbell elementary school students take pride in being neatly groomed and fashionconscious. However, they should always be dressed appropriately for the school environment. Students should wear clothing that is appropriate, durable and comfortable. Clothing that is NOT appropriate includes short skirts, tight shorts (also bike shorts or spandex type) and shirts, blouses or tank tops that expose the stomach or exhibit inappropriate language or images. Students are not allowed to wear caps or hats during school hours unless it is part of a school function. Students are not allowed to wear hoodies. Students should wear shoes that are comfortable for walking. Flip flops and house shoes are not permitted. Due to the unique environment in each elementary school, parents and sponsors should address specific questions about school attire with the specific building administrator.
