Fort Campbell Community Schools maintains a dress code to foster a safe, orderly, and professional learning environment for our youth and to align with the DoDEA Vision Statement of “Communities Committed to Success for All Students.” Proper appearance not only makes a good impression to others but also has shown to have a correlation to positive student behavior and increase student achievement.

Wassom students must comply with the FCCS dress code policy and are to remain in compliance with the dress code throughout the school day. Several students arrive to school daily without a belt. The policy states, **“Belts are required if pants have belt loops.”** Belts must be worn and fit actual waist size without any excess hanging down. Studded belts or large belt buckles are not acceptable.

Please take a moment to review the dress code policy with your child to help ensure compliance with the dress code. Beginning Monday, September 26th, the office will contact parent/s of student who are out of compliance and ask them to bring their child a belt to school. Students who continue to violate the dress code policy will be assigned after school detention for non-compliance of the FCCS dress code policy.
