



Emergency Forestry Conservation Reserve Program Radio Public Service Announcements (Air August 6 - December 31, 2007 only)

60-Second PSA:

Attention forest landowners and operators.

The U-S Department of Agriculture is holding an emergency program sign-up to help you restore hurricane-damaged forests.

The Emergency Forestry Conservation Reserve Program will help reduce flood effects, protect water sources, decrease erosion and improve wildlife habitat.

Producers who lost at least 35-percent of their merchantable timber on private forests – as a result of hurricanes Dennis, Katrina, Ophelia, Rita or Wilma in 2005 – may be eligible.

Your land must be in Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Florida or North Carolina.

The sign-up deadline is December 31st, 2007.
