The incumbent will occupy this position until they are certified by their agency or the completion of our 3-year team rotation which ends March 31, 2012.

Applications will be accepted through **June 1, 2010**. The area of consideration includes the Rocky Mountain and Great Basin Geographic Areas.

- -- A copy of your Fire Training and Experience Record.
- -- A copy of your Incident Qualifications Card ("red card").
