The Rocky Mountain Geographic Area (RMA) is soliciting applications for Incident Commander Type 1 Trainee (ICT1(t)), to fill a vacant position on our Type 1 team (Paul Summerfelt IC). The incumbent will occupy this position until they are certified by their agency or the completion of our 3-year team rotation which ends March 31, 2012.

Applications will be accepted through **June 1, 2010**. The area of consideration includes the Rocky Mountain and Great Basin Geographic Areas.

Submit the following items to apply:

- A completed RMA IMT application (available at <http://gacc.nifc.gov/rmcc/administrative/rmcghome.html>). Ensure that your application is signed by your immediate supervisor and any other required local line and staff officers.
- A copy of your Fire Training and Experience Record.
- A copy of your Incident Qualifications Card ("red card").

Submit your application package through your sponsoring agency's channels to your agency's Operations Committee Representative (see list at [http://gacc.nifc.gov/rmcc/administrative/rmcg\\_ops.html](http://gacc.nifc.gov/rmcc/administrative/rmcg_ops.html)). Applicants from outside the RMA who do not have an agency representative on the RMA Operations Committee should submit application materials through the Colorado State Forest Service representative.
