- All children attending DoDEA schools are eligible to use the program -- even if their parents are not serving in the U.S. Military. Tutor.com provides complimentary access for non-military students because we want 100% of students in every DoDEA classroom to have access to the program.
- Tutor.com is open 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, which means your students can connect to expert tutors anytime, with no appointment, for help with any tricky homework assignments they may be facing. We have approximately 2,500 tutors on staff to help your students.
- There is no paperwork or cost for any DoDEA school, teacher, administrator, or student to participate. Simply point your students to <a href="https://www.tutor.com/military">www.tutor.com/military</a>.
- Many DoDEA students do not know that this program exists because it is a DoD program for *all military children* as opposed to being a program exclusively for DoDEA. As a result, DoDEA HQ is constrained in its ability to use official channels to spread the word, and we currently rely mostly on word of mouth to get the word out to all teachers, students, and parents.
