Uses of Web Services

PRISM

- Law Enforcement at Roadside
 - USDOT and License Plate Readers
- IRP registration
 - Keep the local PRISM files as a backup

SAFER

- Provide query capability to the XML processing of SAFER for CVIEW states
- Provide data to the roadside inspection stations.

Data Source for Web Services


SAFER

SAFER-PRISM database is the only data source

PRISM

- More than one data source:
 - SAFER-PRISM database
 - MCMIS database: Authoritative source of the real-time Carrier Safety Status

SAFER

- Download Transaction:

 - T0041P: PRISM Target Vehicle Registrations
 - □ T0042P: PRISM Target Carriers

PRISM vs. SAFER Carrier Inquiries

Output Data Fields

PRISM T0042P

- Only provides the Carriers that are under a Federal OOS or Targeted for Inspection
- Returns limited Census information

SAFER T0031v2

- Returns all MCMIS Census records (including non-Targeted carriers)
- Contains more census fields: Entity Type, Carrier Operation, Address, Phone, etc.

PRISM vs. SAFER Carrier Inquiries

Data Timeliness and Benefits

PRISM T0042P

- Returns the MCSIP Steps real-time from MCMIS
- No TIN for USDOT Number validation
- Can be used to determine which vehicles are OOS or Targeted.

SAFER T0031v2

- The MCSIP steps are not real-time (one day older than MCMIS)
- Can be used for USDOT Number validation (contains TIN, Entity Type, MCS150 Update Date)

PRISM vs. SAFER Vehicle Inquiries

Output Data Fields

PRISM T0041P

- Does not return "non-targeted" vehicles
- Contains limited registration information
- Three methods to query
 - USDOT (returns all targeted vehicles)
 - License Plate + State
 - VIN

SAFER T0028v3

- Returns both Targeted and Non-Targeted
- Contains more Registration fields: IRP account; GVW etc.

PRISM vs. SAFER Vehicle Inquiries

Data Timeliness and Benefits

PRISM T0041P

Provides real-time MCSIP Step of the Safety Carrier to which the vehicle is registered.

SAFER T0028v3

- Only returns the Target Indicator ("T")
- Does not return MCSIP Steps, which are used to decipher OOS versus Targeted Vehicles.

Benefits of PRISM Web Services

- Real-time Safety Status for Carriers via live data link access to MCMIS database.
- Connect to SAFER-PRISM database for latest vehicle updates:
 - □ Timelier data versus daily file downloads.
- Provide the "Target Only" Carriers and Vehicle Registrations

Access to the Web Services

PRISM

- Network Security
 - Internet-based
 - No PII data
- Connection Authentication
 - No UAS required
 - No username and password required
 - Fixed IP address is required
 - HTTPS (SSL v3 protocol) is required

Access to the Web Services

SAFER

- Network Security
 - Not accessible via Internet only
 - FCMSA VPN is required
- Connection Authentication
 - UAS account is required
