2012 PPD Testing Change for Puerto Rico DoDEA Schools

There has been a recent change regarding PPD testing (Tuberculosis Skin Test) for the Puerto Rico DoDEA Schools as recommended by our local medical treatment facilities. A PPD will now be required upon registration and thereafter every two years. This applies to all students. Parents please check your child's immunization record for the date of their last PPD and if the last test was prior to January 2010, it is time to re-test. The result of the skin test is mandatory.
