Pursuant to the NRUF/LNP Protective Order issued by the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") on April 18, 2011, Sprint Nextel Corporation ("Sprint") hereby notifies the Commission of the pendency of additional requests for the disclosure of information contained in the Numbering Resource Utilization and Forecast ("NRUF") reports and carrier-specific local number portability ("LNP") data.

In addition to the nine states identified in Sprint's June 28, 2011 notification in the above-referenced dockets, the company has recently received subpoenas from attorneys general in the states of California and Kansas in connection with their review of the pending AT&T/T-Mobile USA transaction. These subpoenas require that Sprint provide full, unredacted copies of all materials that it has submitted to the Commission regarding the proposed transaction, including its Petition to Deny, Reply Comments and all accompanying declarations.

Because these submissions contain NRUF and LNP data, Sprint hereby notifies the Commission of these requests and the intended disclosure of NRUF and LNP data pursuant to paragraph 15 of the NRUF/LNP Protective Order. Sprint additionally requests that the Commission issue a Public Notice as expeditiously as possible to notify affected carriers of the potential production of the requested materials.

All of the respective authorities have assured Sprint that their offices will treat the information as highly confidential business information exempt from all applicable disclosure requirements, including any state-specific Freedom of Information Act or Public Records Laws, to the maximum extent possible. Sprint has also requested that it be provided with notice and the opportunity to object should any third party seek access to these materials.
