<u>CAVEAT</u>: Equipment brought from home units must conform to established Army standards and guidelines. DSS Cadre will make the final determination on whether or not an item of equipment is suitable for DSS training. Universal Camo Pattern is the only authorized pattern (Multi-Cam is not authorized for use at DSS).
