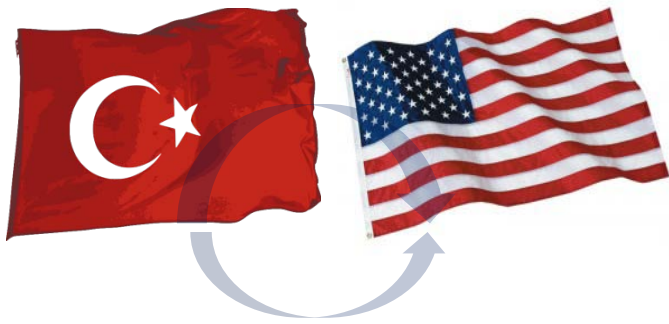




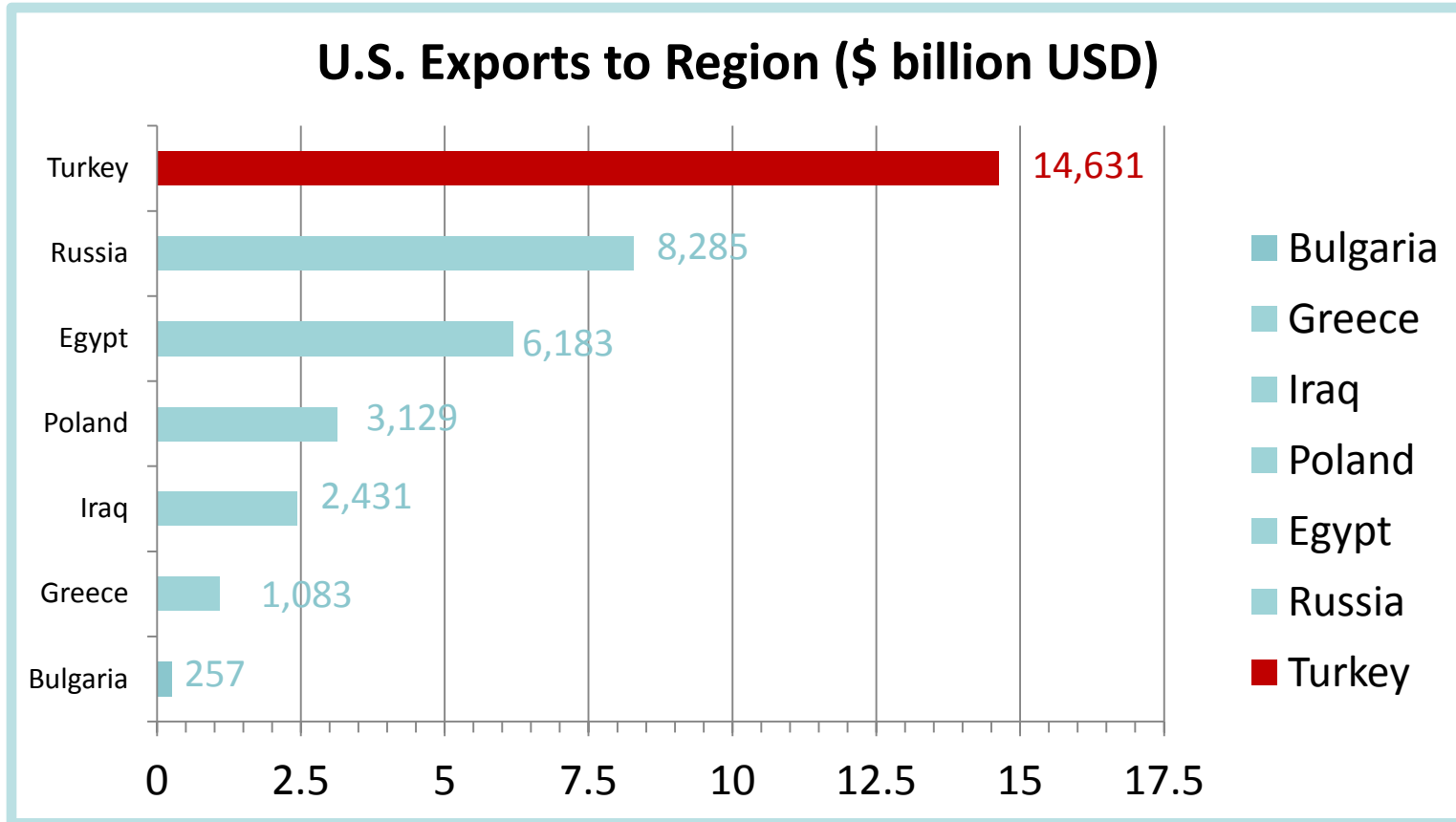

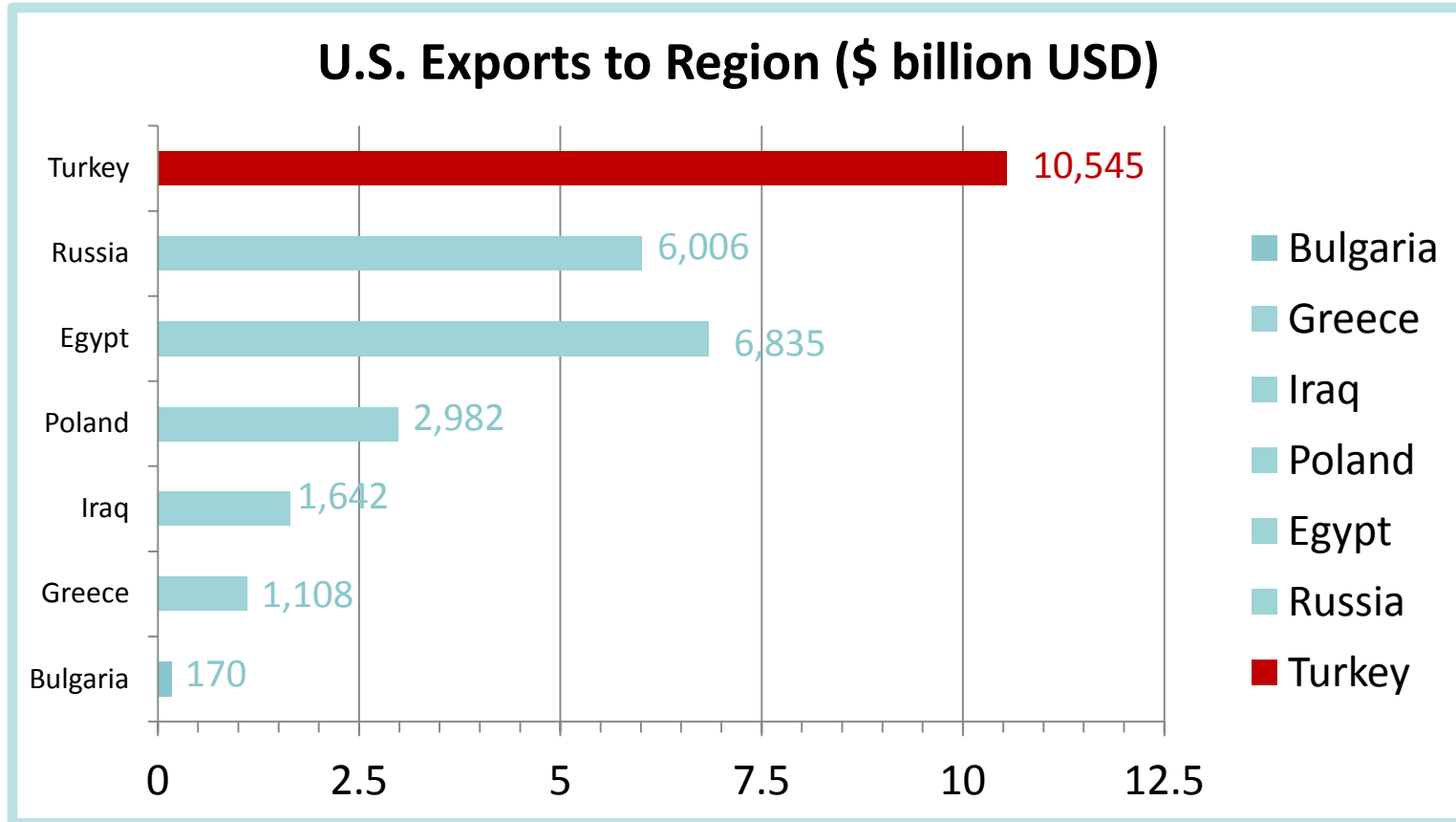

U.S. Exports: Regional Markets Comparison (2011)



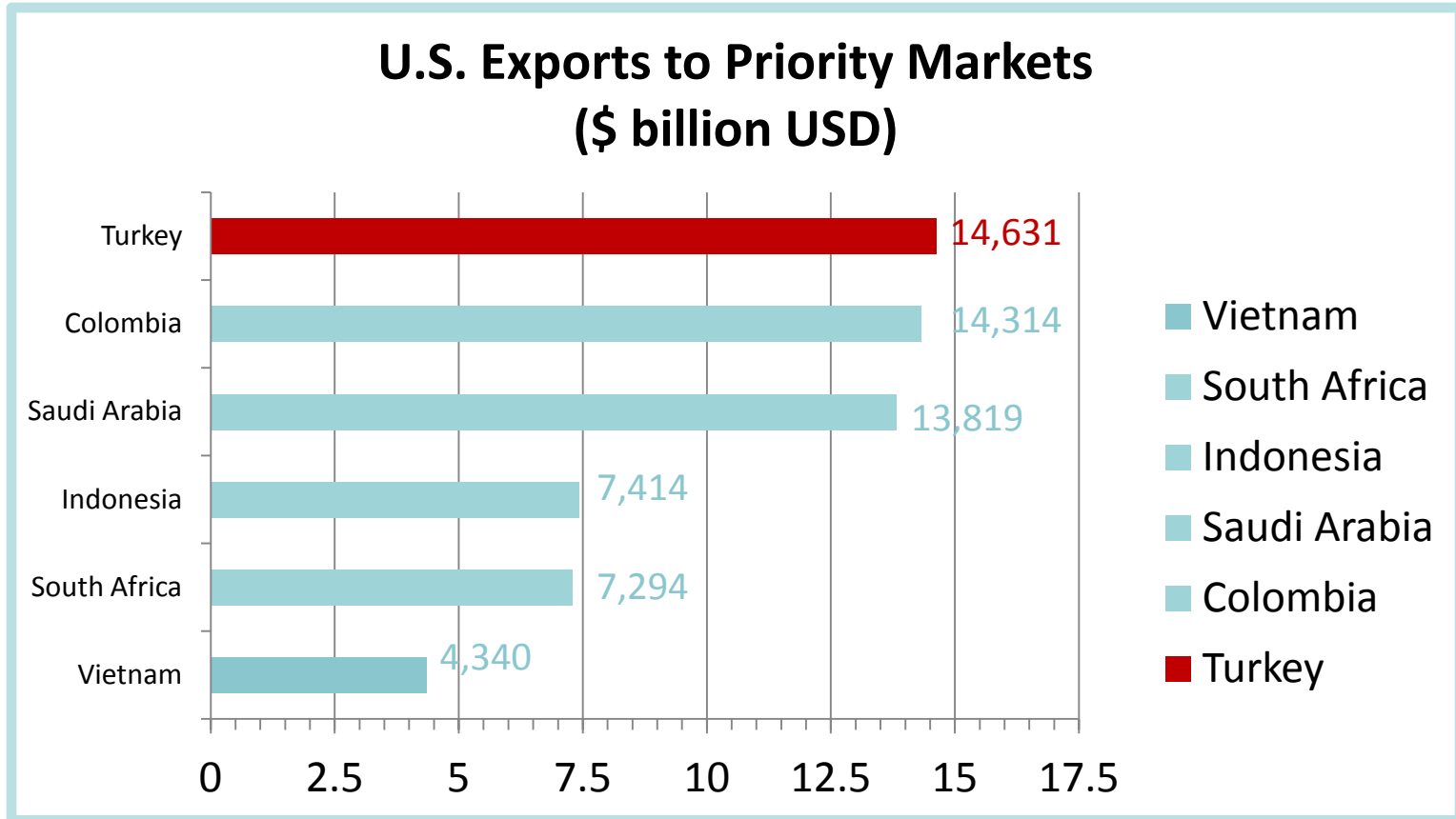

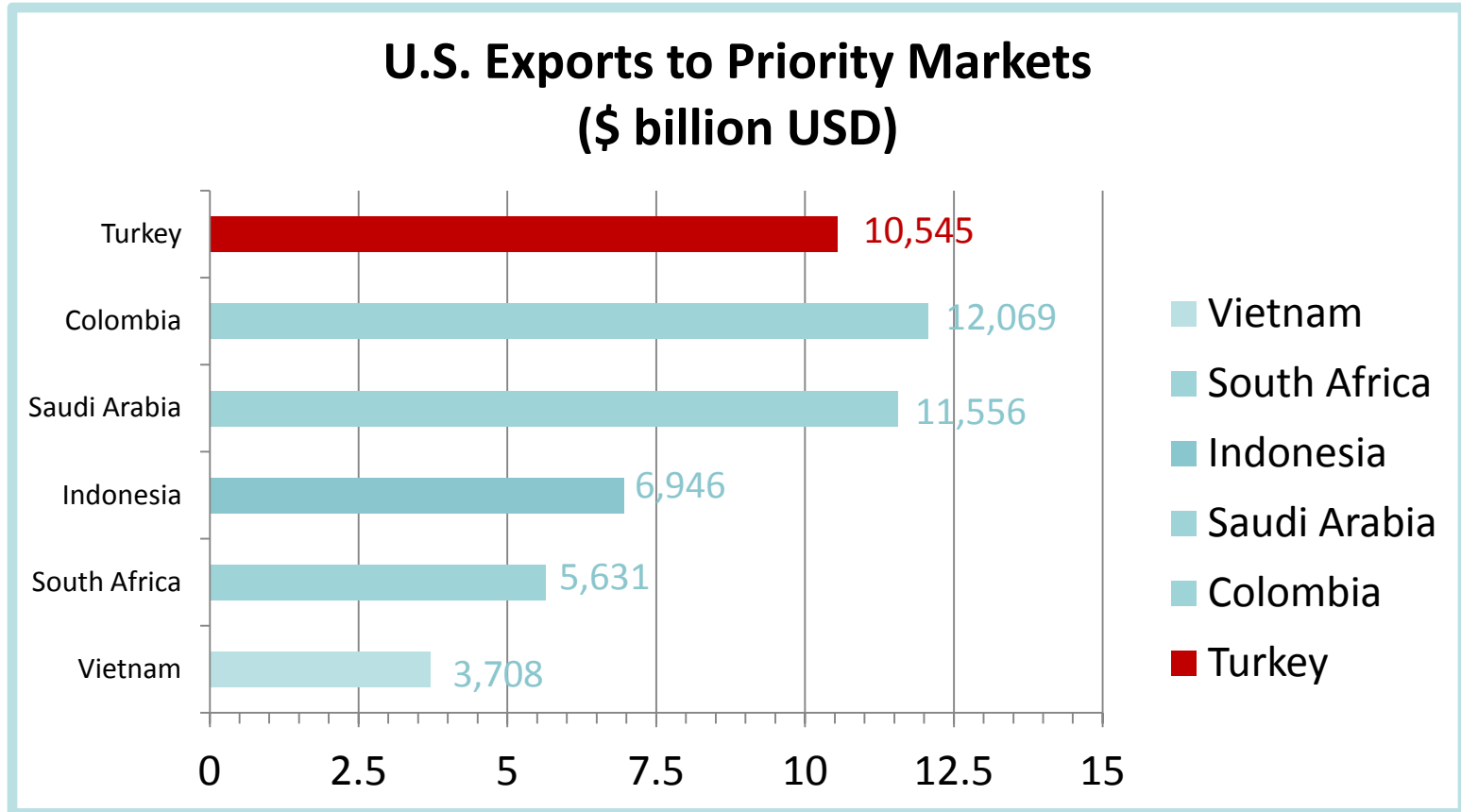
U.S. Exports: Priority Markets Comparison (2011)

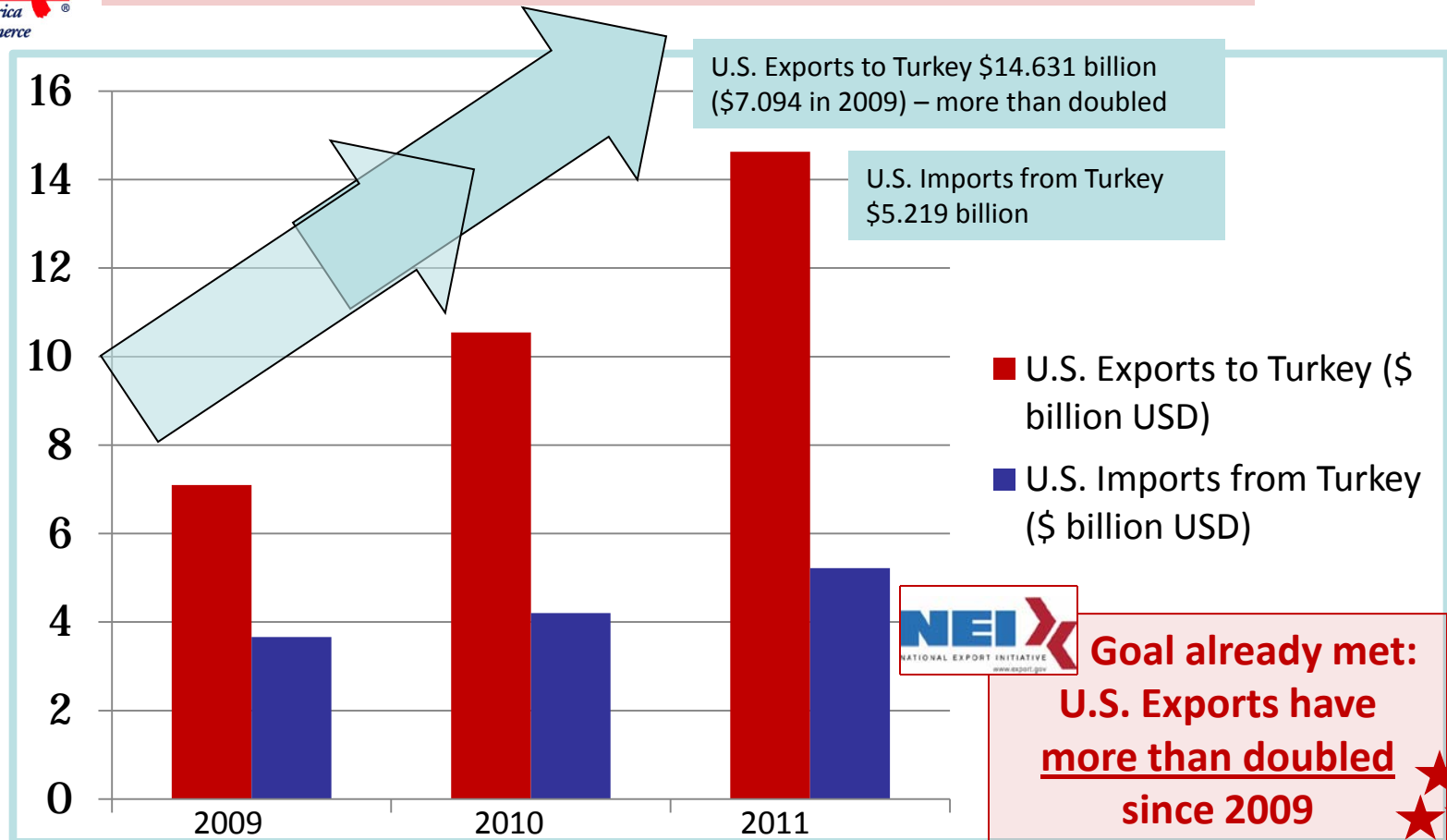
- Turkey now leads all USG-designated priority markets

Trade Volume 2009-2011: A Snapshot

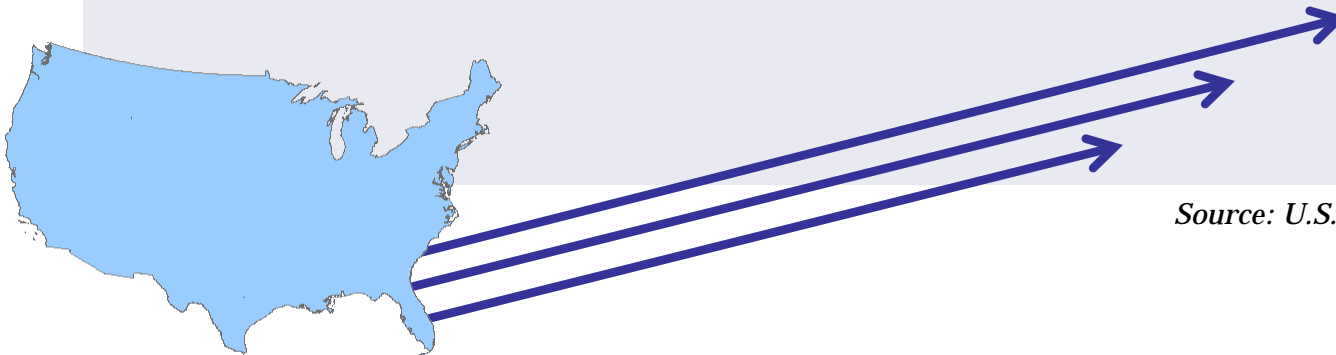

- Total Trade 2009: **\$10.756 billion**; Total Trade 2010: **\$14.752 billion**
- Total Trade 2011 - **\$19.851 billion** - has broken all records for the full year.

- U.S. commercial and ag exports to Turkey (2011): **\$14.631 billion**
- U.S. commercial and ag exports to Turkey, (2010): **\$10.545 billion**
- Percentage Increase YOY (Year On Year):
38% increase, \$4.086 billion

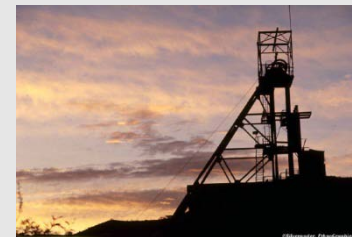

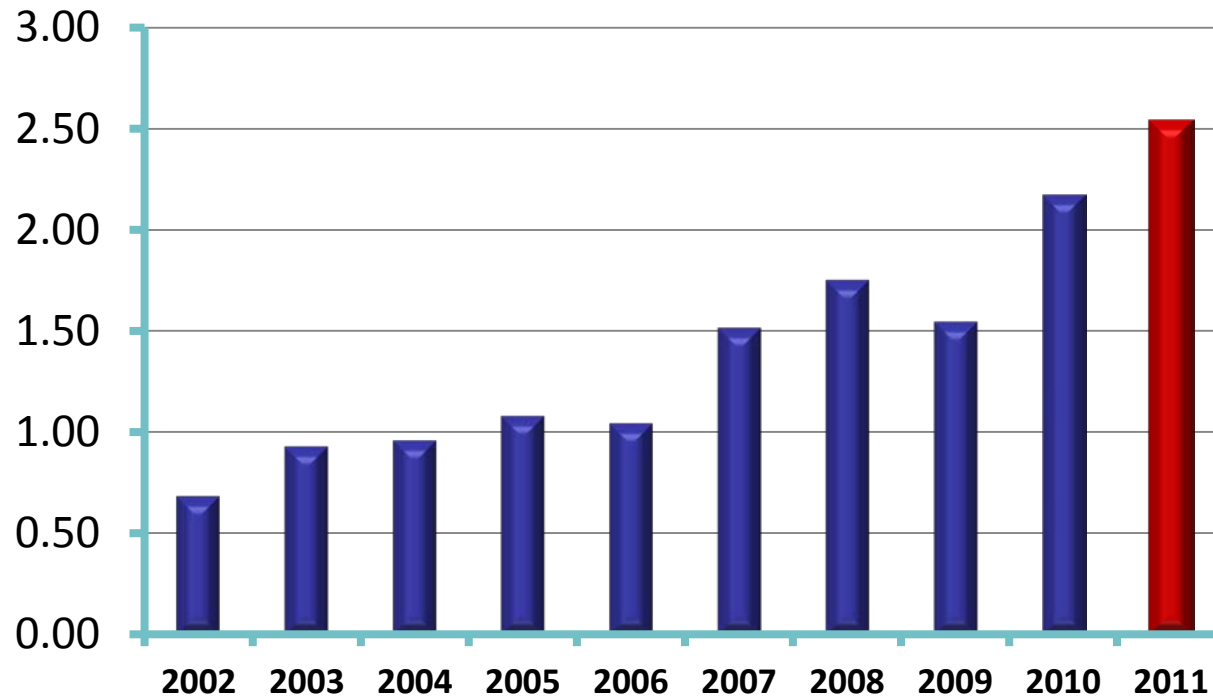


Foreign Agricultural Service

U.S. Ag Exports (Billion \$)

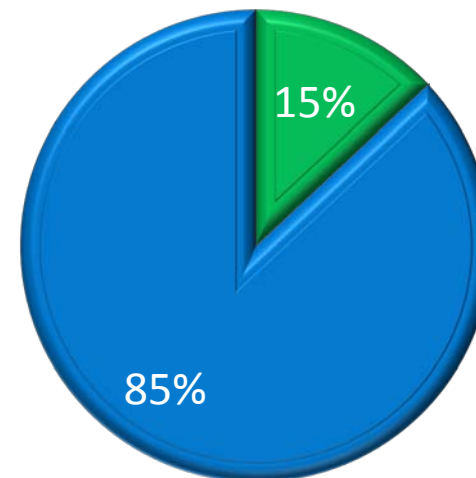

- The U.S. and Turkey are partners in agriculture, and U.S. exporters provide critical inputs for Turkey's food and fiber manufacturing and export industries.
- Turkey re-exports or adds value to over 85% of products it imports from the United States.

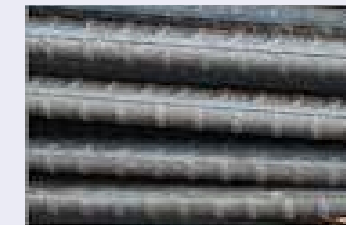

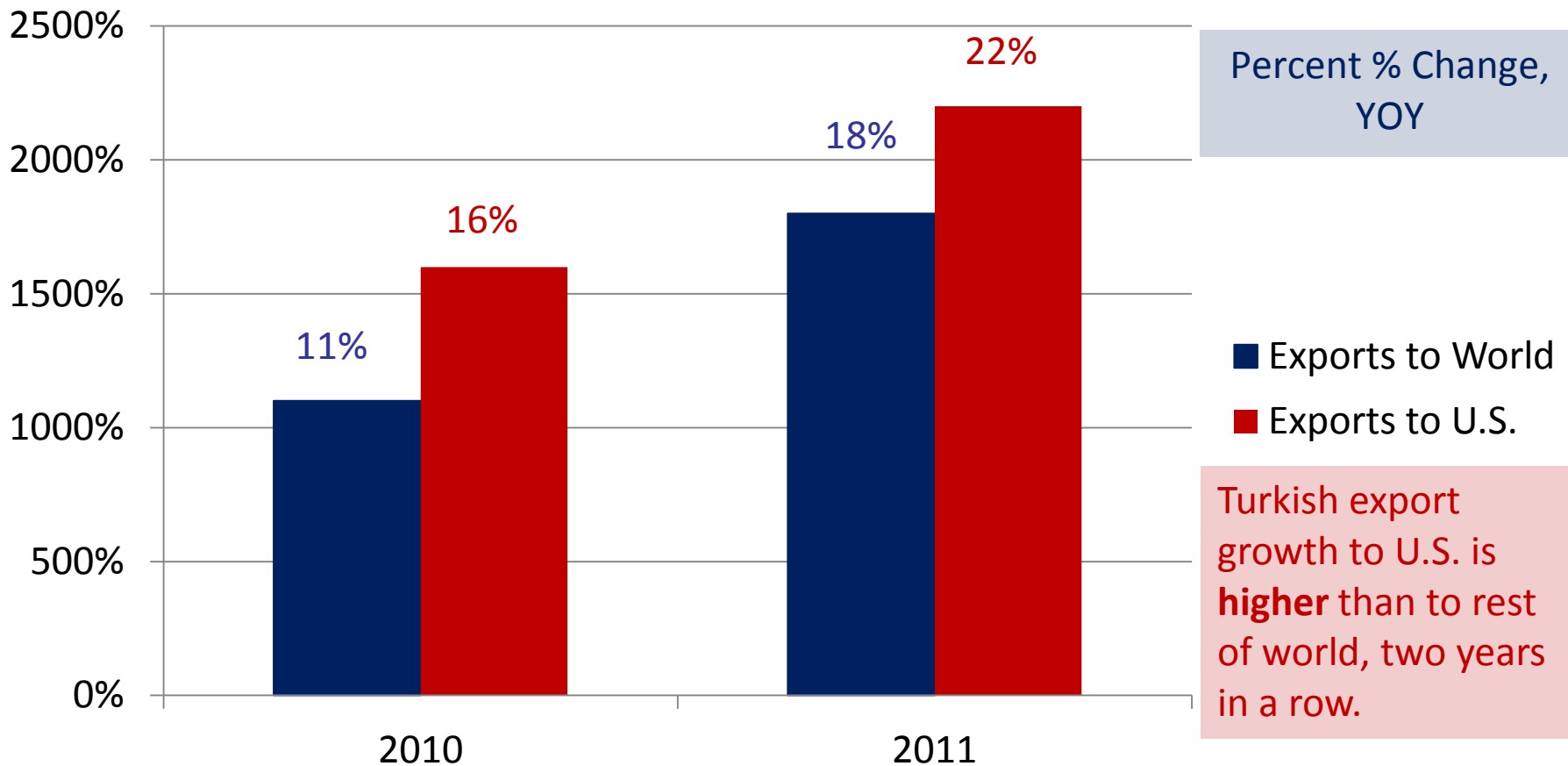

Growth in Total Bilateral Trade: G2G Cooperation Producing Results for U.S.-Turkish Business



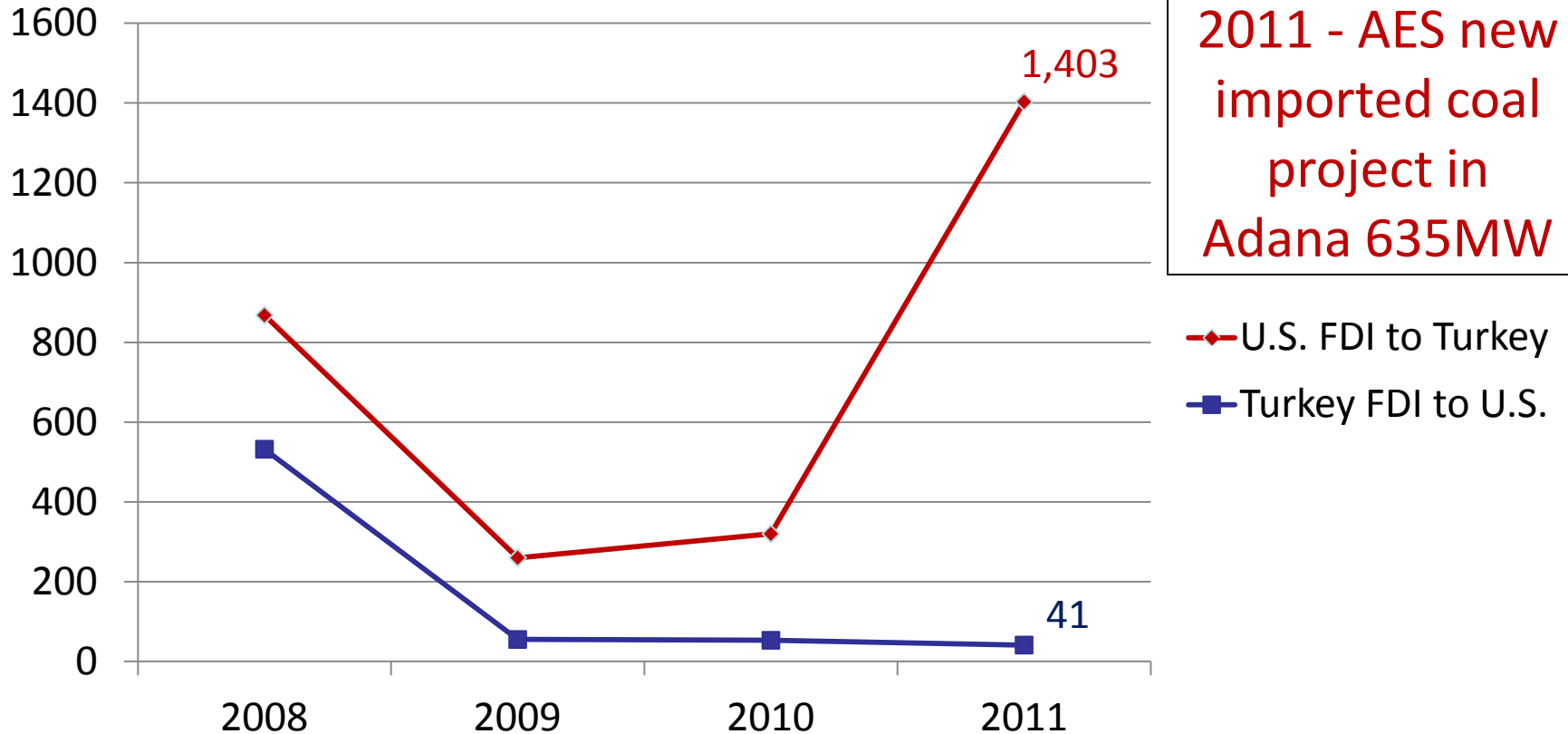
U.S.-Turkish Framework for Strategic Economic and Commercial Cooperation met in October 2010; focused on increasing trade and investment ties.

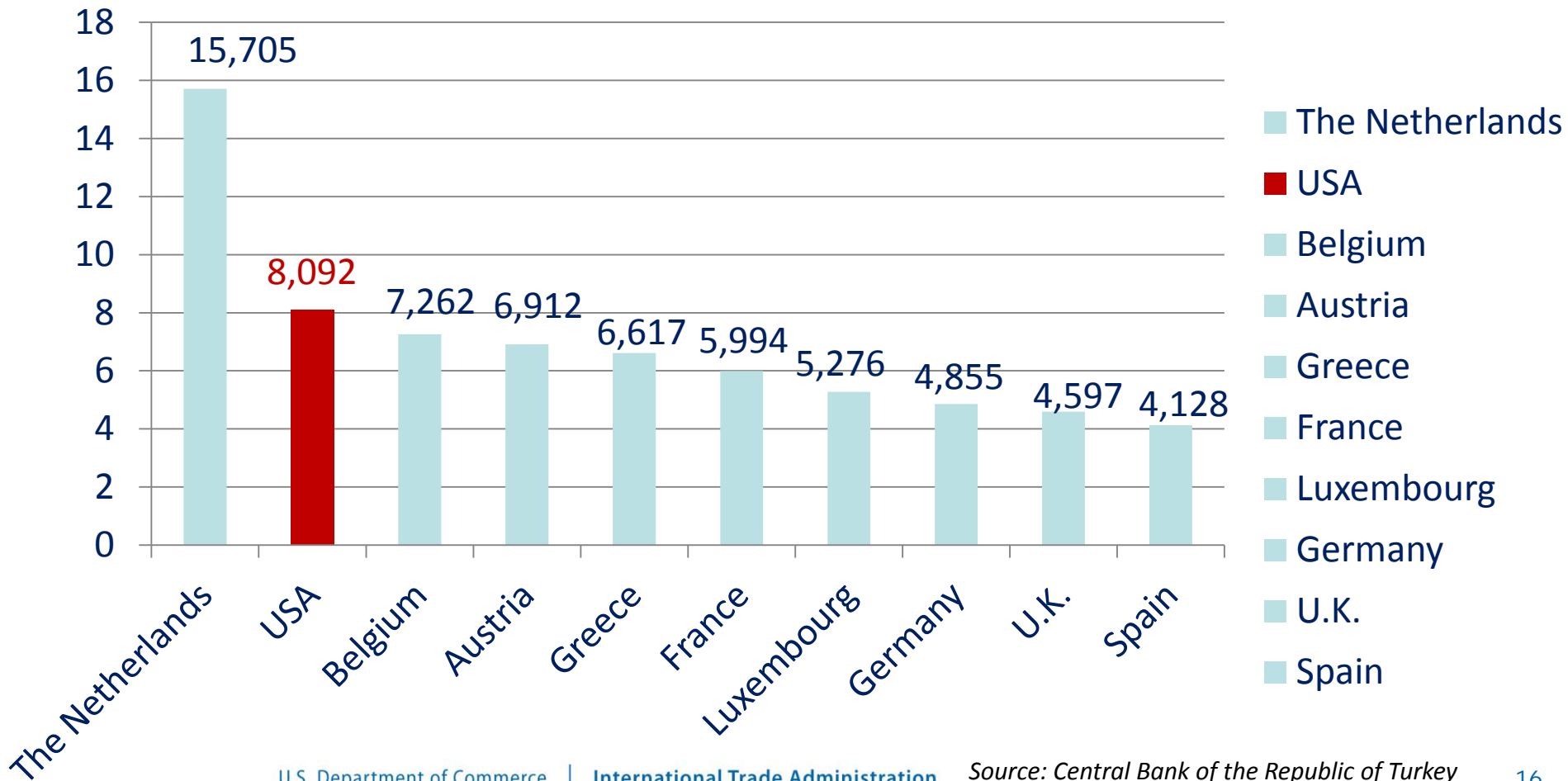
U.S. and Turkey FDI Inflows, 2008-2011 \$ Million USD



*In 2011, the U.S. is the **fifth largest investor** of equity capital in Turkey

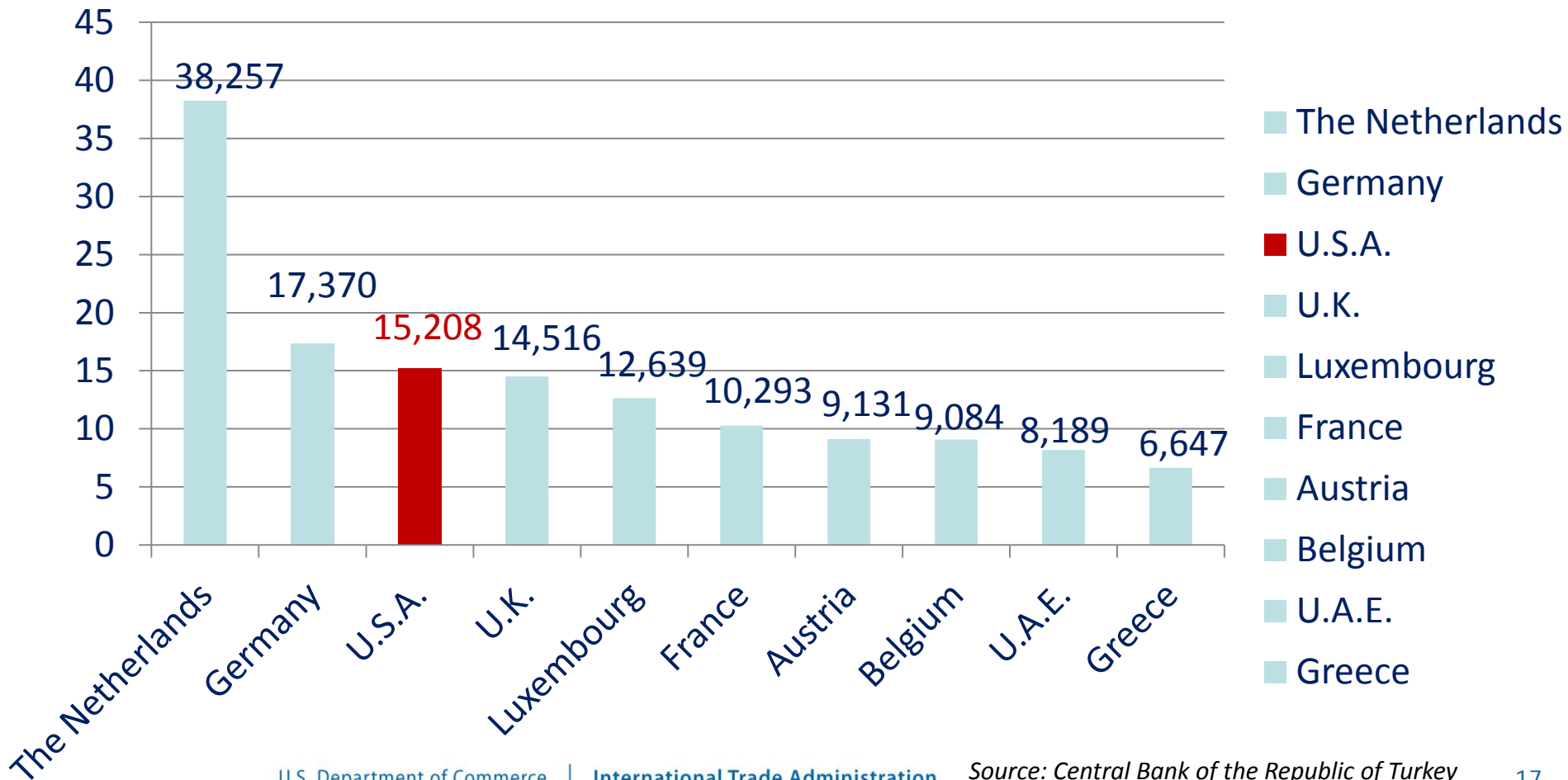
According to ISPAT, U.S. is second largest investor in Turkey in the last 10 years
