OVERVIEW 1

Purpose This regulation provides guidance for the use of the *Phantom Warrior*. 1a

Applicability This regulation applies to all units assigned, attached, or training on the Fort Hood military installation. 1b

General Frank A. Frazetta has given III Corps and Fort Hood the rights to use his painting titled *Death Dealer*.  
Within III Corps and Fort Hood the *Death Dealer* will be titled and referred to as the *Phantom Warrior*. 1c

Use There will be no changes made to the *Phantom Warrior*.  
The *Phantom Warrior* can be superimposed over a caltrop or a caltrop can be placed in the background.  
The *Phantom Warrior* can be used on T-shirts, bumper stickers, etc., without any provocative inscription. Use will be kept in proper decorum and good taste. 1d

RESPONSIBILITIES 2

Public Affairs Office The III Corps and Fort Hood Public Affairs Office ensures that use of the *Phantom Warrior* is kept within the bounds of the Memorandum of Agreement between Frank A. Frazetta and the Commander, III Corps and Fort Hood and good taste. 2a

• submit written request for proposed uses of the *Phantom Warrior* prior to using it to Commander, III Corps and Fort Hood, ATTN: AFZF-PO.  
• attach a sketch of the proposed design with the request. 2b
