
CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS


WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of July 2010.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Naturalization receipts in July 2010 increased 20 percent when compared to July 2009, while approvals/oaths decreased by 10 percent and denials decreased 38 percent.

The number of pending N-400 cases reached 308,471 in July 2010, an increase of 22 percent compared to the same month in fiscal year 2009.
