
CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS

WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of January 2011.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Naturalization receipts in January 2011 increased 13 percent when compared to January 2010, while approvals/oaths increased by 15 percent and denials decreased 11 percent.

N-400 Naturalization Applications: Received, Approval/Oaths, and Pending

The number of pending N-400 cases reached 283,407 in January 2011, an increase of 15 percent compared to the same month in fiscal year 2010.

¹ The Performance Analysis System (PAS) is the USCIS System of Record for capturing and reporting field office and service center performance data. The G-22.3 is the PAS data entry worksheet used to collect the monthly Naturalization statistics.
