1. Purpose. To effect a change in the subject organization's status from a Category 2 to a Category 1 Detachment.
2. Background. SUPSHIP Pearl Harbor was disestablished in FY-86 and its functions were transferred to the Industrial Management Division of Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard. In FY-88, the SUPSHIP functions were separated from the shipyard and assigned to a new Category 2 Detachment under SUPSHIP San Diego. The basic mission, tasks, facilities and core personnel of the organization remained unchanged throughout these changes.
3. Discussion. Following the establishment of SUPSHIP San Diego Detachment, Pearl Harbor, experience quickly showed that the unit needed to be elevated to Category 1 status. This change was needed to permit the organization to expand to more than 50 employees and to allow it to be listed in the SNDL. The growth in personnel was required to reduce reliance on TDY from San Diego while the inclusion in the SNDL was needed to speed the flow of correspondence and reduce the volume of paperwork moving through the SUPSHIP in San Diego.
4. Action. The Supervisor of Shipbuilding, Conversion and Repair, USN, (SUPSHIP) San Diego Detachment, Pearl Harbor, HI is converted to a NAVSEA Category 1 Detachment, under an Officer in Charge, in accordance with reference (a). FUNCTIONS AND TASKS  
SUPSHIP SAN DIEGO DETACHMENT, PEARL HARBOR, HI

- A. Administer Department of the Navy and other Department of Defense shipbuilding, design, conversion, and facility contracts at assigned private shipyards.
- B. Procure and administer overhauls, repairs, alterations, activations and inactivations performed on naval ships at private yards under Master Ship Repair Agreements and Agreements for Boat Repair or other suitable contract types.
- C. Perform contract administration services for all Department of Defense contracts awarded to plants assigned in accordance with the plant cognizance program.
- D. Conduct engineering, technical, and design oversight, evaluation, and surveillance to the extent necessary to evaluate contractor performance in the areas of design, development and production during construction on contracts assigned ACO responsibility.
- E. Budget, administer, and account for funds required for planned direct operation and projects assigned and accepted. Obtain, administer, and account for funds required for customer-funded operations and projects assigned and accepted.
- F. Monitor and evaluate integrated logistics support, including supply support, technical documentation, training and fleet introduction interface, procurement of Government Furnished Material (GFM), and the outfitting of ships.
- G. Serve as the communications focal point for NAVSEA, SUPSHIP San Diego and CINCPACFLT with private shipbuilders in the Pearl Harbor area.
