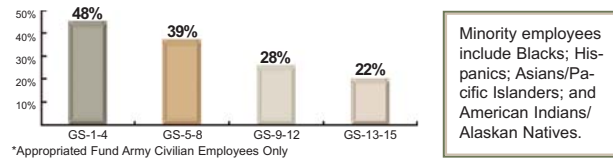

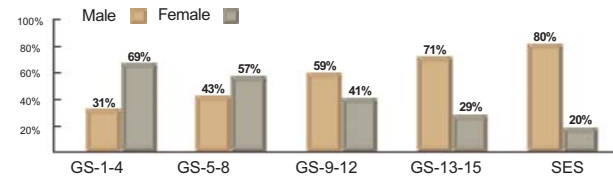
ARMY CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES (EXCLUDES NATIONAL GUARD)

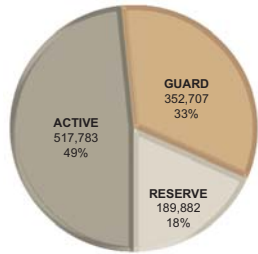

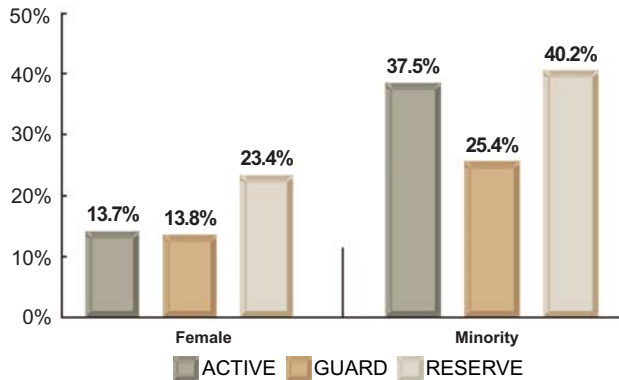
TOTAL ARMY

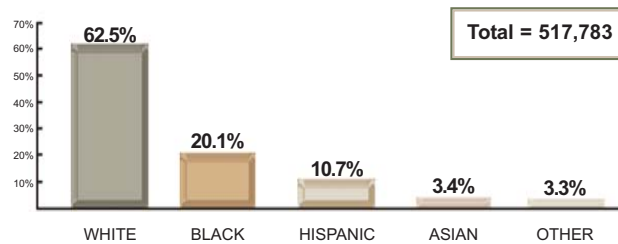
