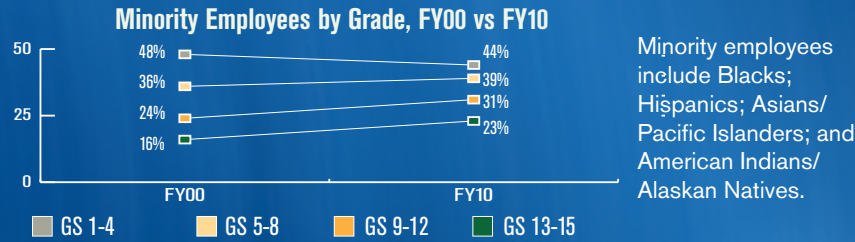

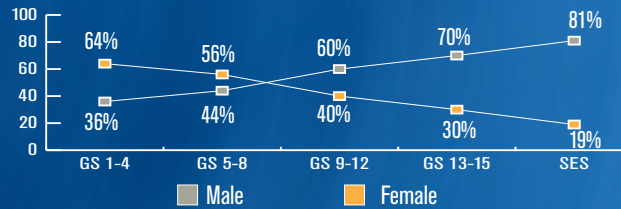


## US ARMY CIVILIANS

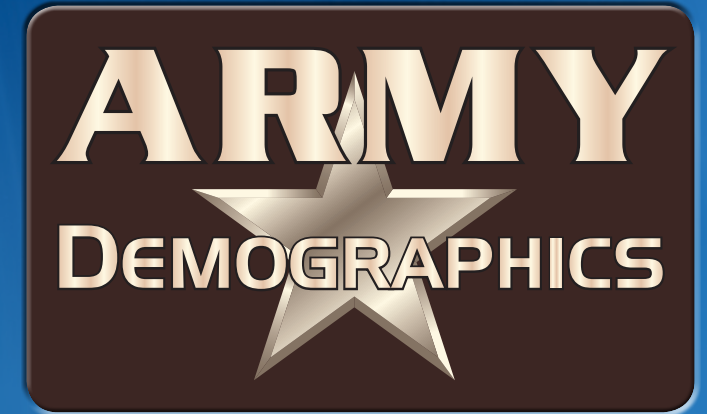

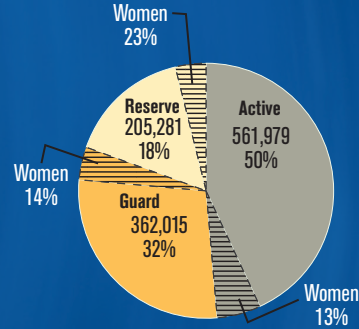

Total Strength of the Army



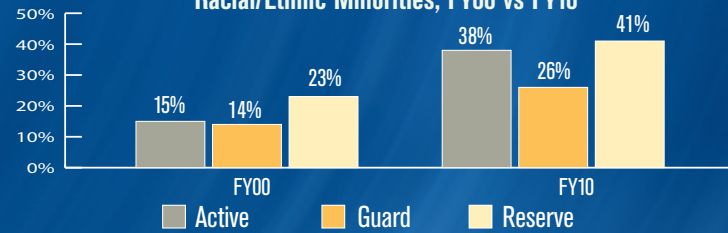

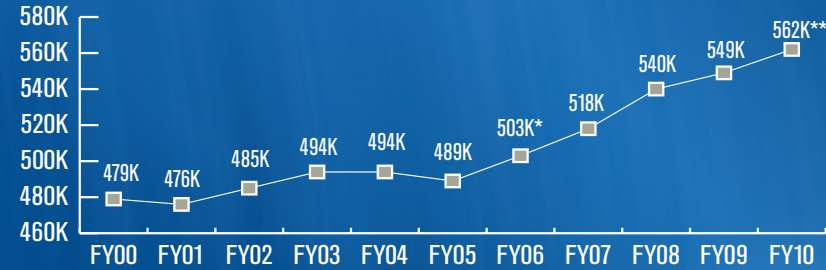

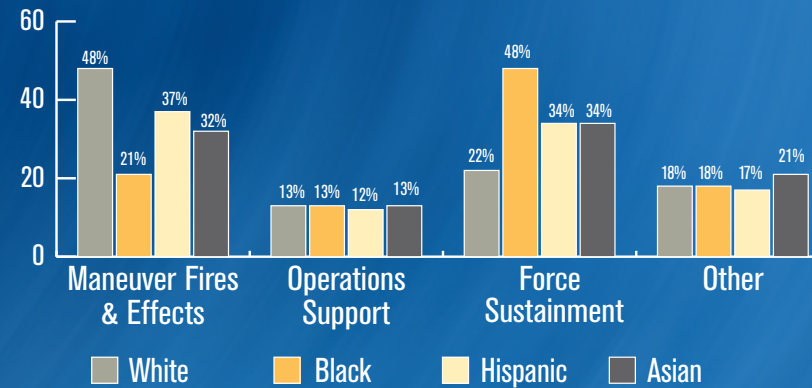
Active Component Army, FY00-FY10

Active Component Army by Branch and Race/Ethnicity, FY10 (Enlisted Only)



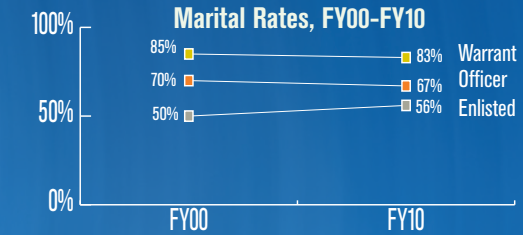

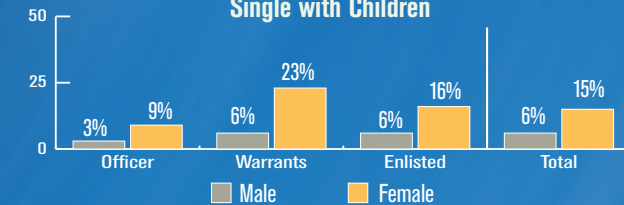


Since FY00, the marital rate for Enlisted Soldiers has steadily increased, while the rates for Officers/Warrants have decreased.
