### NRC NAMES NEW SENIOR RESIDENT INSPECTOR AT CALLAWAY NUCLEAR POWER PLANT



The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission has selected Tom Hartman as the new senior resident inspector at the Callaway plant located near Fulton, Mo.

“Tom Hartman’s background and experience will assist the NRC in carrying out its mission of protecting people and the environment and ensuring the safe operation of nuclear power plants,” said NRC Region IV Administrator Elmo E. Collins.

In January 2009, Hartman joined the NRC Region III offices located in Lisle, Ill. as a reactor engineer. He has served as the resident inspector at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant in Ohio since 2010.

Prior to joining the NRC, Hartman worked at the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant operated by Xcel Energy as a licensed control room supervisor and fuel handling supervisor. He served in the Navy on board the USS Carl Vinson (CVN-70) and as an instructor at the Naval Prototype Training Unit in Ballston Spa, New York. Hartman holds a bachelor’s degree in Nuclear Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant site has at least two NRC resident inspectors. Hartman joins resident inspector Zach Hollcraft. They serve as the agency’s eyes and ears at the facility, conducting inspections and monitoring significant work projects.
